The church is therefore the spiritual domain made possible, or purchased by, the blood of Christ (Acts 20:28;1 Corinthians 6:19,20). This relationship is also
described as the spiritual body of Christ (Ephesians 1:23; Colossians $1: 18,24$ ) and (Ephesians 1:23; Colossians 1:18,24) and
also as the kingdom of Christ (Colossians

13; Hebrews 12:28).
When a person is baptized "into Christ" When a person is iptized in same tim
(Romans 6:3), he is at the satist baptized into the church of Christ (Acts 2:38-41), the body of Christ ( 1 Corinthi-
