on an across-the-board basis." We have a sales tax, therefore the issue in this campaign is the method to be used in amend ing this Tax Law in order to arrive at a just and equitable Our present Tax Law is based on Pennsylvania Sales Tax
which went into effect in 1956 at $3 \%$ and is now at $4 \%$. Penn-

working now, nor has it ever worked. The tremendous State Bureaucracy set up to administer this law merely puts an
additional burden upon people of Pennsylvannia. Texas said they could solve this problem of administration. In Texas it and the individual. I do not call that a solution. It is merely
passing the buck on an unworkable Sales Tax Law. Our four neighboring States of Oklahoma, Kansas, Colo-
rado and New Mexico have an across-the-board Sales Tax. These taxes were enacted in 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1937 as a
$2 \%$ Sales Tax and are all now operating at $2 \%$ except Kansas which has increased to $21 / 2 \%$. They are a proven workable
Sales Tax, and my solution to our Tax problem would be along
the lines of the Sales Tax in these States using the form of a Retail Sales Tax in preference to a Gross Receipts Tax.
