The Wheeler County Commissioner's Court met Monday, December 22, 2003 at 10:00 a.m., in the Courthouse Annex at 410 S. Main St. in Wheeler. There were eight items on the agenda.

The commisioners voted to meet the payroll as presented.

The court voted to pay the bills. Commissioner Hubert Moore had one change on the budget. The county had received a \$4,000 insurance check for damage to a structure in Moore's precinct. He requested \$5,000 be moved from Roads & Bridges into the materials account to pay for the repairs. The request was approved.

The court considered the adding of heating tape to the handicapped parking on the north side of the courthouse. It was learned the cost would be prohibitive as well as the cost of heating the parking space.

The commissioners agreed to leave the burn ban in place.

Item Number 6 was a resolution for Violence Against Women grant. The District Attorney's Office is not going to apply for the grant at this time. The item was tabled.

The Wheeler County Development Board ask the commissioners to consider making arrangements for the board to use the Old Jail as a tourism information center after the courthouse is complete. Office space would have to be made available for the District Attorney's office. With visibility from either Hwy 83 or 152, the old jail is an excellent location for the information center. South Texas already enjoys large numbers of tourists taking nature tours and with the North Texas Wildlife map now available, Wheeler County can expect our tourist traffic to pick up. The court voted to set the salary for acting sheriff Rick Walden to be set at \$2,312.38 per month with benefits to remain as they were during the time he serves in this capacity. He will be the acting sheriff beginning January 1, 2004, with the retirement of Sheriff Jimmy Adams. Court adjourned after all items on the agenda were addressed.

The Grants were part of a \$92,500 total package of grants given in Xcel Energy's Texas, New Mexico, Oklahoma and Kansas territory.

The largest of the grants, \$40,000, is to help develop educational outreach at the Globe-News Center for the Performing Arts in downtown Amarillo. The Center is a \$30 million project that is being funded from private dollars as a gift to the City of Amarillo.

Included with a state-of-the-art performance hall will be an education center to provide every child in the region with the opportunity to attend a performance during the school year.

Holiday Safe Driving Targets Drunk Driving


Santa has a warning for Texas motorists: He knows when you've been drinking. He knows when you're .08.

So do thousands of law officers trained to identify drivers who've reached the state's legal limit for intoxication. And they'll be patrolling Texas streets and highways in December in an effort to reduce alcohol-related traffic deaths and injuries.

TxDOT's lively new campaign, which features several tongue-incheek holiday slogans based on Christmas carols, has a deadly serious message. If you drink this holiday season and get behind the wheel, you'll find more than coal in your stocking come Christmas Day. Expect penalties ranging from stiff fines and drivers license suspension to spending time in jail.

DWI prevention messages are appearing on TV, radio, billboards, gas pumps and decals and coasters in bars and restaurants statewide. The public education campaign is part of a concerted effort between December 19 and January 4 to change Texas' standing as the national leader in alchololrelated traffic fatalities. Impaired drivers are to blame for more than 1,700 deaths and 25,000 injuries in Texas each year.

"If alcohol is involved in holiday celebrations, we're reminding drivers to designate a driver who hasn't been drinking, or take a cab," said Carlos Lopez, TxDOT's traffic operations director. "It may be the season to be jolly, but we want Texas motorists to know if you drink and you drive, you go to jail." Texas Department of Public Safety and more than 600 local law enforcement agencies will be out in force during the holidays to keep Texas roads and highways as safe as possible.


