The Wheeler County Commissioners will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 8 percent. Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on 08/21/2008 09:00 AM at Wheeler County Courthouse. The second public hearing will be held on 09/03/2008 09:00 AM at Wheeler County Courthouse.

The members of the governing body voted on the proposal to consider the tax increase as follows: For: Daryl Snelgrooves, Tom Puryear, Hubert Moore, John Walker Against: Present and not voting: Absent:

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Wheeler County last year was \$29148. Based on last years tax rate of \$0.29357 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$85.57.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Wheeler County this year is \$31942. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$0.248901 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$79.5.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$ 0.268812 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$85.86.

Members of the public are encouraged to attend the hearings and express their views. Special Provisions if Applicable

Criminal Justice Mandate (for counties): The County Auditor certifies that County has spent \$0 in the previous 12 months beginning for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. County Sheriff has provided information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for reimbursement of such costs.
