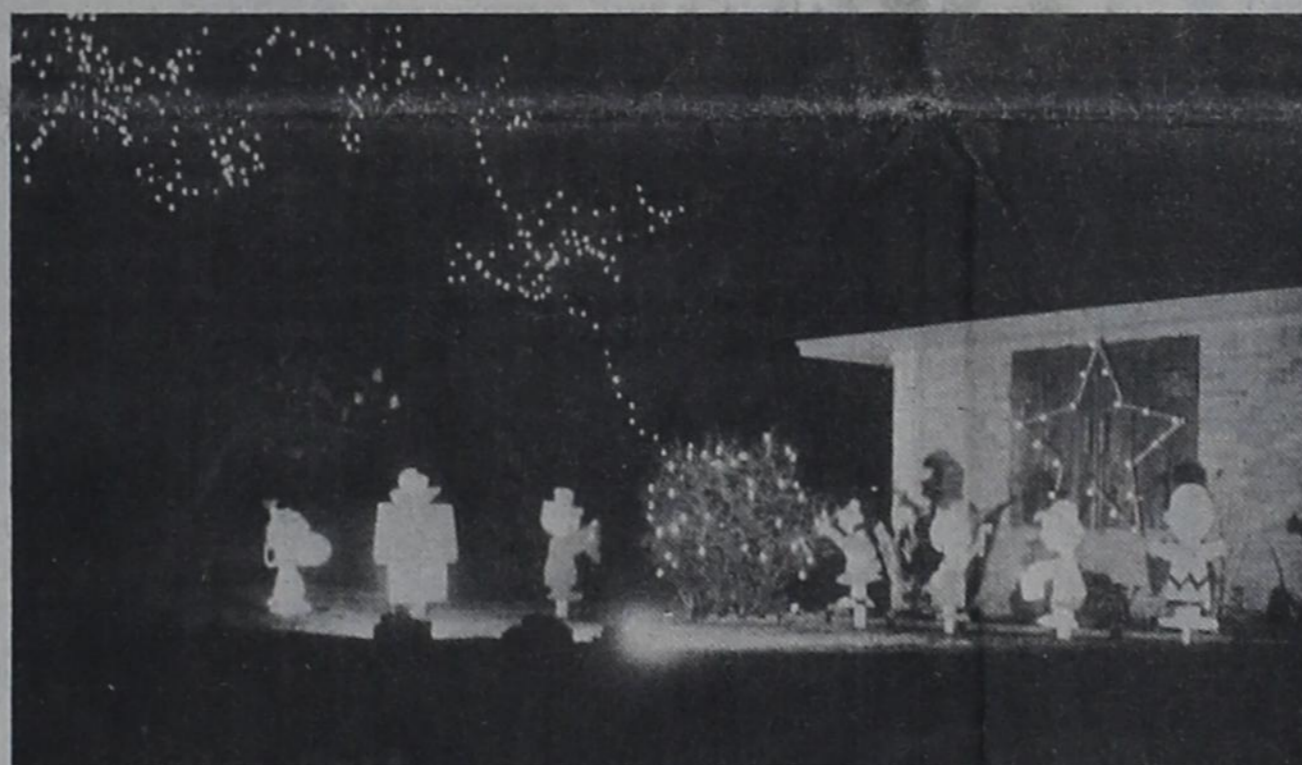

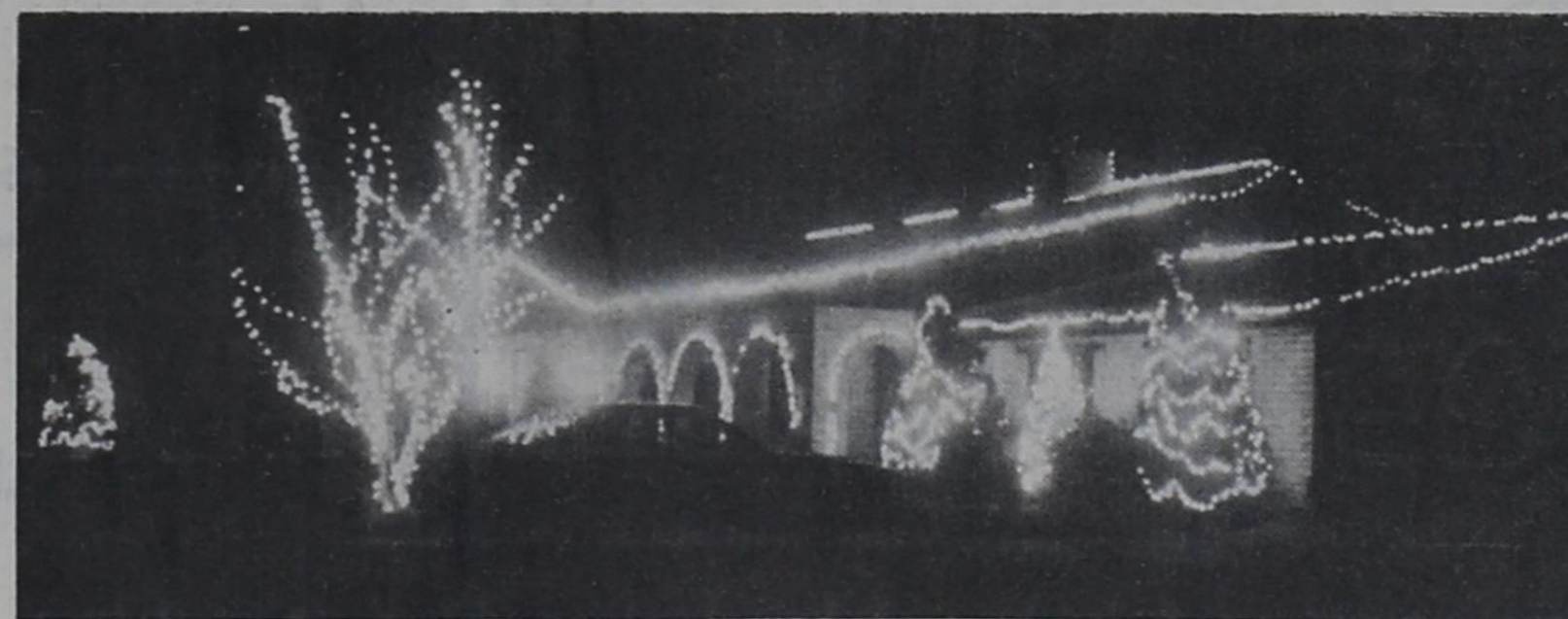
You will receive one ticket per each dollar purchase—up to a maximum of \$500.
