Eight Lucky Shoppers To Share 'Cash'

The fourth of the four Wheeler Chamber of Commerce 'Cash' drawings will be held Saturday, December 23; \$400 will be given away. During the month of December a total of \$1500.00 will be divided into 58 envelopes for the individuals who shopped in Wheeler. \$300 was given away Saturday, Dec. 2, and \$400 was given both Saturdays, December 9 and 16.

The time of the drawing for Saturday will be 3:00 P.M. and the amount to be handed out will be \$400. The division of the money will be 4-\$25; 2-\$50 and 2-\$100.

The annual Christmas Drawing is again being offered by the progressive merchants of Wheeler. Certificates will be given away during December totaling \$1500. The merchants of Wheeler feel this is one way they can thank you, their customers, for the support you have given them during the year and are giving you a chance to share the profits.

Merchants began giving tickets on Monday, November 27. You are eligible for a ticket each time you enter a sponsoring business; with each dollar spent, you will receive an additional ticket—up to 500 tickets per purchase.

As has been the practice for the past several years, script is given away to the lucky individuals instead of cash. The script can be spent like money with any of the participating merchants. The 'money' will be in \$5 increments.

Remember, each time you enter participating stores, you are entitled to a ticket; ask for it, sign it, deposit the ticket in the containers, which are conveniently located in the sponsoring firms.

You will receive one ticket per each dollar of the purchase value up to a maximum of \$500.

When the day of the drawing arrives, all of the tickets will be placed in a large container and the winners drawn. You **MUST** be present to win; however, husbands and wives may claim each other's prizes.

Each sponsor giving tickets will display a poster in their window, indicating they are giving drawing tickets.

Drawing tickets have been available since Monday, November 27, 2006 at sponsoring businesses.

The City of Wheeler, Texas, by this Order, hereby prohibits outdoor burning in all of the incorporated area in Wheeler County, Texas. This burn ban takes effect November 18, 2006, and will terminate February 18, 2006, Ninety (90) days from the date.

Burial was in Memory Gardens Cemetery in Pampa, Tx., under the direction of Wright Funeral Home, Wheeler, Tx.

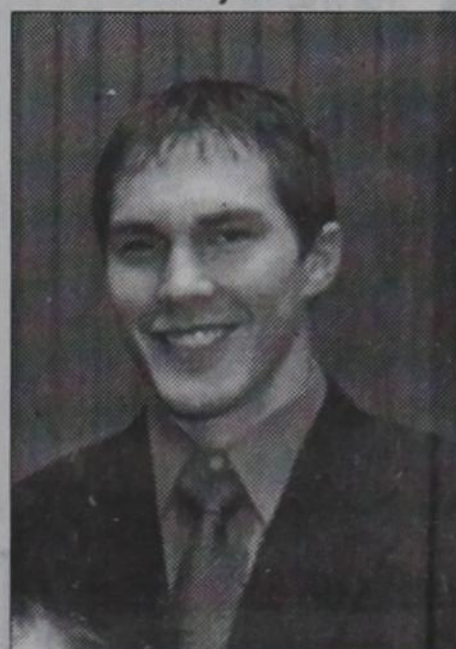

Puffy Jell-o. 1 small package of strawberry sugar free gelatin, 1 small package of raspberry sugar free gelatin, 2 cups of boiling water, 1 1/2 oz. can of crushed pineapple, drained and reserve the liquid, 1 8 oz. of neufchatel cheese, softened, 1 cup miniature marshmallows, 1 1/2 bowls of whipped topping, 2 bananas, 2 tablespoons flour, 1 cup sugar substitute, 1/2 cup of nut pieces. Drain the pineapple juice into a sauce pan. Set aside. In another sauce pan bring to cups of water to a boil. Remove from heat. Add both packages of gelatin to the boiling water. Stir until dissolved. Add 1 cup of marshmallows and stir until dissolved. Will be frothy until cooled to almost gel stage. Spray your serving bowl, rectangle casserole dish or mold with Pam. While the gelatin is cooling whip the 8oz. of neufchatel cheese and 1/2 cup of sugar substitute in a small bowl. Slice bananas into bottom of pan or mold. Stir pineapple into the gelatin and pour 1/2 of the mixture or enough to cover the bananas in the pan or mold. Put in refrigerator to set. Add the remaining pineapple gelatin mixture to the cheese mixture and until well blended. Add 1/2 bowl of whipped topping to the cheese and gelatin mixture. Smooth over the set banana and gelatin mixture. Put back in the refrigerator to set. Meanwhile add the remaining 1/2 cup of sugar substitute and 2 tablespoons of flour to the pineapple juice. The pineapple juice will be only about 3/4 cup of juice top off with the apple juice or water to make 1 cup. Stir until flour and sugar substitute

are dissolved. Bring to a rolling boil and cook until thickened. Cool. Add to 1 bowl of whipped topping and fold in until smooth. Spread over the gelatin mixture and refrigerate until ready to serve. Add a few pecan or walnut pieces to the top before serving if desired. The layers tend to slip and separate from each other if left at room temperature too long. It's still good, just harder to serve. You can any combination of colors and flavors to tempt your guests. Enjoy.
