

On this 18th day of NOVEM-BER, 2006, the Wheeler City Council, Wheeler County, Texas, met in C misdemeanor pursuant to Secregular session and found that circumstances present in all the incorporated area of the City of Wheeler, create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, therefore,

this Order, hereby prohibits outdoor burning in all of the incorporated area in Wheeler County, Texas. This burn ban takes effect November 18, 2006, and will terminate February 18, 2006, Ninety (90) days from the date.
