Ideas to Aid Hostesses With Bridal Shower

If you're to be hostess for a bridal shower this spring, you'll want to go all out on your table decorations to get your party off to a good start.

Happily, a festive bridal shower table need not be expensive. In fact, with a little imagination, you can easily do the decorations yourself, using readily available materials.

For example, you can make a clever umbrella centerpiece out of a small toy umbrella and paper napkins. Paste napkins to the inside of the open umbrella first. Then cut large circles out of napkins, pinch them together in the center and paste them to the top of the umbrella. Start at the edge and work toward the center. Decorate with flowers and a ribbon bow, then wrap the handle with

napkins. Place the finished umbrella and secure with a bow of la in a styrofoam base, decorated narrow satin ribbon. Cut two with more napkin circles, flowers three-inch circles from a napkin for the hat and paste them to the top of the cleaner. Then decorate the hat with a few blossoms.

Bride and bridesmaid dolls are easily made, too. You'll need three colored pipe cleaners for each doll. Bend and twist the cleaners into figure forms; no head is necessary. Just twist two cleaners together half way down, leaving the bottom half for legs and feet. Take the third cleaner and twist it around the body at the middle to form arms.

Open two Kleenex napkins (regular or new Casual size) to full size and trim off the corners to make circles. Cut a small hole in the center of each napkin and thread both napkins onto the body. Paste the napkin skirts to the body, placing one skirt over the other. The edge of the skirt should cover the feet of the doll.

Now tie ribbon over the pasted edge of the skirt and make a bow in back. Tape the feet to a circle of cardboard. Bend the ends of the arms around a small flower bouquet.
