Sometimes it may be hard to define a "fair share. This can occur in dividing oil or ga

As we all know, oil and gas

Here in Texas many wells have been allowed more oil or gas than they should bave becaule they were drilled on very small tracts. That extra oil or gas came from under the neighbors' land.
Some oilmen made a regular Some oilmen made a regular practice of this type of
peration. Obviously, one owner got more than his fair share - others, less. People in 26 out of 29 oil-producing states have found a way to divide their oil and gas so that each owner gets what is rightfully his. They simply put their small acreage
together and share the costs and income. This system is known as POOLING.
Such a system is needed in Texas. It is proposed in a
bill now before the Legisiature, HOUSE BLIL 5510. When
