





### Representatives Are At Road Mass Meeting

More than two hundred representatives present at the meeting in the county court room Wednesday afternoon for the discussion of a proposed cut-off highway from Ranger to Weatherford.

The southern part of Palo Pinto county through which the proposed road is routed was especially represented and the representatives expressed their favor of building the highway.

A bill will come up for consideration at the highway commission meeting Wednesday, and the representatives of the cities along the proposed route are urged to send delegates to the meeting. These delegates will hold a meeting at the hotel in Austin on the evening of the 23rd and complete final resolutions for presenting their side of the question.

Resolution to building the road was adopted by the highway commission of cities along the proposed route and will be presented at the hearing on the highway bill.

Milburn McCarty of Palo Pinto county is a representative of the cities. "If we are to have a highway it will help immensely in favor of the construction of the highway," he said as many delegates present at the meeting.

passed unanimously, which read: "To Governor R. S. Sterling, Austin, Texas, this 24th day of February, 1932, resolve as follows, to-wit: "We deplore that the question of the construction of highway 89

has been attempted to be made a political issue, and an attempt has been made to induce you to become a partisan against the construction of this road.

"It is the judgment of this meeting that you should not become a partisan to either side, and we believe you should follow the precedent heretofore established and permit the highway commission to exercise its sound judgment as it has heretofore done."

The resolution to the highway commission read:

"We, the representatives of those people living along the proposed highway No. 89, between Ranger and Weatherford, and also those living west of said proposed cutoff along the Bankhead highway, as well as those people in other sections that will be benefited by the construction of said proposed highway, in meeting assembled at Eastland, Texas, this

the 24th day of February, 1932, would respectfully represent and show:

"That we heartily favor the building of said highway and insist that the construction thereof is fully warranted and justified, and in support of our position submit the following reasons:

"First. The thickly settled section of Palo Pinto county and the western portion of Parker county, through which this proposed highway is to pass, is without a surfaced highway and the construction of this road will mean much toward the development of said territory and the conveniences of its people.

"Second. The people of Eastland and Callahan counties, as well as those living to the south, will be afforded a shorter and safer road to Fort Worth and Dallas. The proposed highway, running in a northeasterly direction from

Ranger mountain direct to Weatherford, is 14.21 miles shorter than by the road as it now runs around through Mineral Wells, avoids the dangerous road through the hill country of Palo Pinto county, eliminates four railroad grade crossings, and saves from 40 to 60 minutes actual traveling time.

"Third. The people living along the Bankhead highway west of Callahan county, as well as those living to the southwest, will likewise be afforded a shorter and safer route to Dallas and Fort Worth.

"Fourth. The Bankhead highway is the main traveled road between El Paso and Fort Worth, traverses the most densely populated counties between these two cities, passes through some of the leading towns and cities of West Texas, and the people living along said highway and in said towns and cities, as well as the traveling

public, are entitled to have this road maintained and kept in first class condition and improved and shortened whenever practicable, as is now proposed to be done.

"Fifth. A calculation based on an actual count of motor vehicles on the Bankhead highway shows there would be an actual saving which would, in less than two years, pay for the construction of said highway, not to mention the saving in life and limb by reason of the traveling public being given a safe road on which to travel.

"The saving of 14.21 miles over a main highway of travel by the construction of a 45.64-mile cutoff is unprecedented and emphasizes the out-of-the-way course which it is now necessary to travel. Taking into consideration the cost of the proposed cutoff, we know of no highway improvement in this state which would be of more benefit and result in greater actual saving

to the traveling public, neither could there be a more propitious time than the present period of unemployment to proceed with this undertaking.

"In conclusion we request and urge that the honorable highway commission proceed with the construction of said highway and that same be completed without delay."

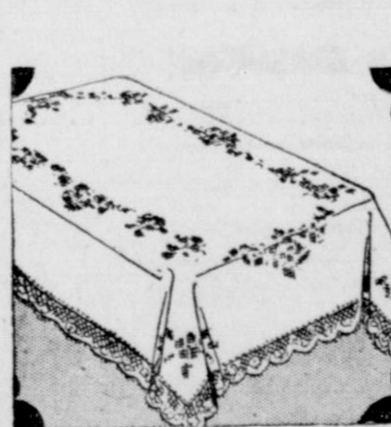
