## to local citizens

Haven't you heard a lot of talk about "excellence in education in Texas?" Unless we're willing
to pay for it, we ought to quit talking about it. Perhaps we can't expect such excellence when in
Texas we don't even pay teachers an "average" salary.
Texas teachers now are $\$ 800$ below the national average.
If we buy the Governor's program the beginning teacher will get only a $\$ 486$ raise spread over
ten year, an average of $\$ 48.60$ a year.
In ten years, Texas would be so far behind that we wouldn't have any new teachers wanting to teach here and trying to survive to become a career teacher. The most any career teacher would get is $\$ 1,296$ spread over ten years.
