The West Central Texas Council of Governments will hold a Region 4 meeting at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 10, in the District Courtroom of Stephens County Courthouse in Breckenridge.

Both public officials of the counties, cities, special and school districts and private citizens are urged to attend the meeting to discuss improvement and development procedures. Members of the Region 4 of Eastland and Stephens Counties are Breckenridge, Carbon, Cisco, Gorman, Eastland, Ranger and the West Central Texas Municipal Water District.

Lewis Tiner, city of Eastland manager, is a member of the application review board. County Judge Scott Bailey, a member of the executive committee, said that each citizen will have an opportunity to suggest plans for developing this area. Bailey said such suggestions might deal with the water quality control in this area, the Morton Valley project to get fresh water piped

to farm homes, or with an academy for law enforcements officers, which the Council has been studying.
