tary invasion of a sort which threatens establishment on a
permanent basis of a European power, is a threat to the
United States, and will be so treated.

coast, or even necessarily to bombardment by sea or air of
its cities. Canada is rapidly becoming the center and heart
of Eritish air defense, both as to the building of planes and
the training of flyers. Should those planes and flyers hold
the balance of power in a widespread European air wat,
the Germans would be more than human if they did not
try to strike at their source.
