The planning and construction of a lignite-fueled power plant like the one pictured here takes just about that long.

That's at least eight years to locate and purchase the right site, order equipment, plan and build the plant, obtain approvals from all regulatory agencies, and then test the plant's operation carefully.

The point is, we can't wait until the day you and your neighbors need more electricity. If we did, you simply wouldn't have it.

That's why we're always looking ahead. We have to. For instance, we've known for some
time that the primary fuels we use to generate electricity - natural gas and oil - would be in short supply and thus more expensive.

Anticipating this, we and two other electric utility companies now have in operation a power plant near Fairfield which uses lignite coal for fuel. And two other lignite plants are currently under construction.

We know that by the early 1980's, we will need still another dependable fuel source - nuclear energy. Plans are under way to have a nuclear-fueled power plant near Glen Rose operational by 1980

Diversifying to these new fuel sources will help decrease our dependence on natural gas and oil.

Unfortunately, plants designed to use lignite cost about two times as much as gas-fired plants. Nuclear plants cost more than three times as much. But we must make commitments now to be ready for the future.

We're working to supply the electricity you need, but it's costing more to make it all the time.
