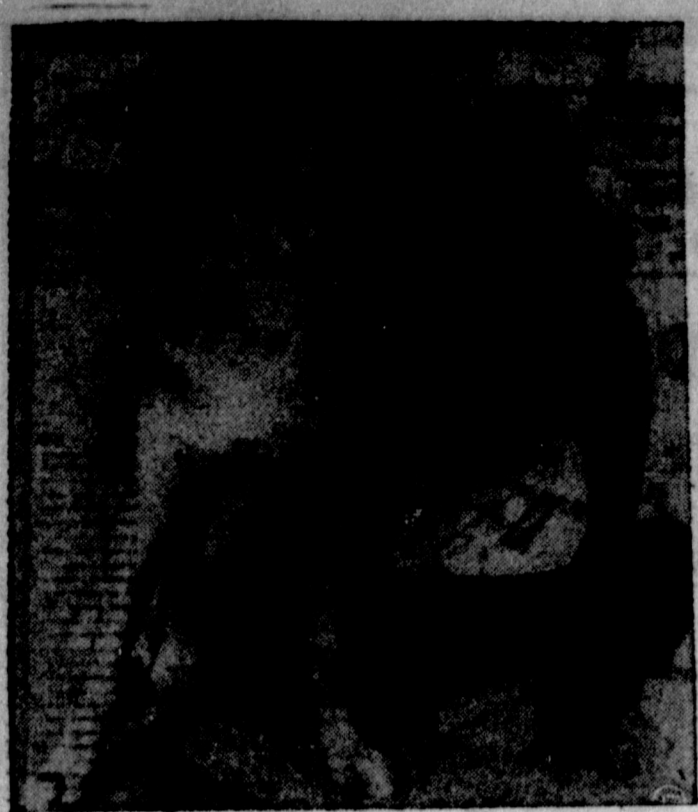

Yes, and it's the hurried last-minute shopper, too. Whether he lives in Pampa, in Newton, or wherever. You know, somehow it's that last-minute shopper Christmas Eve who really has the spirit of Christmas. He has ignored all the exhortations to shop early, he has waited and now he has to do his shopping hurriedly. Yet, somehow, he has time to stop at the corner and there wish the Santa Claus a Merry Christmas. And that's the only, the traditional, way to end this column — to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas.

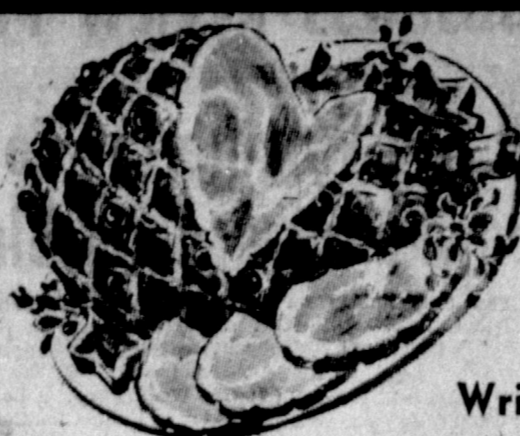

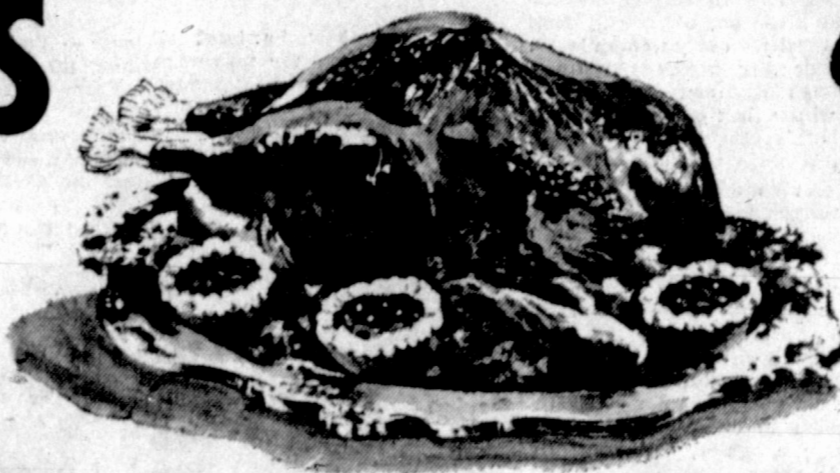

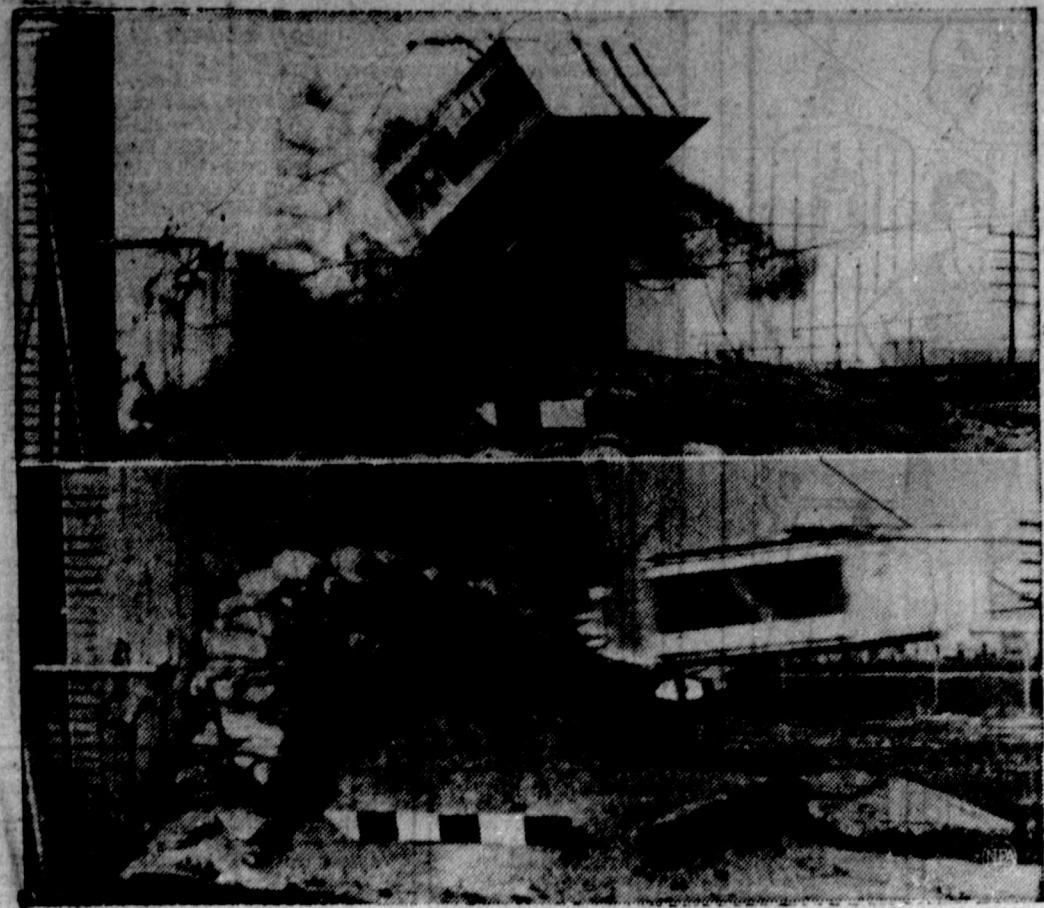

Court Gives \$103,420 To Plaintiff

HOUSTON, Dec. 21-UP- Leonard Peacock, 60-year-old signal maintainer for the Texas and New Orleans Railroad, got a \$103,420 "Christmas gift" from a jury in district court here Monday. The "gift" was a judgement against the railroad, the Fort Worth petroleum engineering firm of Pritchard and Abbott, and Howard L. Deviney, a driver for the Fort Worth firm. Peacock suffered a broken neck and leg and other injuries in May 1952 when he was knocked from a motor handcar by a Pritchard and Abbott auto near Poth, in Wilson county. The jury found that Deviney was speeding and that the railroad had failed to provide proper signal warning devices. Judge W. Sears McGee overruled a railroad motion for mistrial. The defendants said the verdict would be appealed.

CHICAGO, Dec. 21-UP-Two men were killed and two injured in a generating plant explosion that caused an estimated \$10 million damage. The blast rocked the six-story plant.

Nationalist Press Hits Dag's Visit

TAIPEI, Formosa, Dec. 20-UP-The Chinese Nationalist press Monday described United Nations Secretary General Dag Hammarskjold's forthcoming trip to Communist China as appeasement and "dangerous flirting with sinister Red designs." The English-language China News accused the United States of being "inconsistent and weak in moral and ethical principles" by blessing Hammarskjold's mission. "The world policeman in calling on the house of the criminal to recover stolen goods is carrying law in his hands, despite all the honorable and high-sounding principles of the global body to maintain law and order and to deter aggression," the News said. "The action could ruin UN prestige."
