Hollywood Can Take Bow for Creating Big British Stars

HOLLYWOOD (AP)—At a time when Anglo-American film relations are at their lowest ebb, Rex Harrison comes forth with the statement that "Hollywood can well take a bow for creating the big-name British stars."
The actor paused between finishing "The Foxes of Harrow" and taking off to his native England to comment that world-wide fame came to British stars "only after they made films in Hollywood or for Hollywood picture companies." What's more, he mentioned names.
Ronald Colman and the late Leslie Howard reached acclaim after their American films, he said, and David Niven "is entirely a Hollywood-made star." Robert Donat became the star he is today "through 'Goodbye, Mr. Chips,' a film made

for a Hollywood company." Green Garson also achieved eminence in that film, "and enhanced her fame with such Hollywood films as 'Mrs. Miniver'."
"Laurence Olivier would probably not have had a chance at his present eminence if he had not made 'Wuthering Heights' and 'Rebecca' in this country," Harrison added. "Vivien Leigh was acclaimed at home after she made 'Gone With the Wind' in Hollywood."
"That is true with the single exception of James Mason, the only British actor who has become an American and world-wide idol without ever appearing in a Hollywood film."



Leaves From a Correspondent's Life Note Book

NEW YORK — (AP) — The years have caught up with "Sonny," who

lived in an underground penthouse in Greenwich Village and was known as "The poor man's playboy." Time takes all gay blades, but I hate to see Sonny slowing up. He was the freest soul I ever knew. He must have had a first name and a last name, but nobody called him anything but Sonny. He was the big city neighborhood equivalent of the town drunk—certainly not a bum. He was—if there is such a thing—a stationary hobo, anchored to alcohol.

Sonny's binges based on rubbing alcohol, bay rum, canned heat and sometimes even honest whisky—were Greenwich Village epics ten years ago, the themes of friendly harmless corner gossip that knit the neighborhood together. Sonny then was well into middle-age, a slim, tobacco-chewing city hill-billy with a great gift of friendship. Our biggest worry was that he would be run over by a strange taxicab, as he had a habit of lying down in the street and falling asleep. Despite this outdoor life Sonny was the healthiest man in the

neighborhood. He never had a cold. In periods of sobriety he slept in the basement of a drug store—his "underground penthouse". He stoked furnaces, painted walls with cheap calcimine, and always carried out garbage when he wasn't on a spree. His clothes were always patched and nondescript, but Sonny kept himself showered and clean. Constant soap and water were the only luxuries his beaten body and mind ever knew. The greatest bender Sonny ever threw was the day the neighborhood druggist sent him on a delivery errand. Sonny collected a dollar from the customer, bought himself a bottle of "Smoke" and boarded a bus. Back and forth he rode, a nickel a trip until the liquor was gone. "I took a whole double seat to myself," he said later. "I felt like a king."

Pipeline Firm Asks New Note Approval

COLUMBUS, O.—(AP)—The Panhandle Eastern Pipelines Company of Kansas City Thursday asked the State Utilities Commission to approve a \$10,000,000 issue of unsecured promissory notes bearing 1-3/4 percent interest as part of its financing program for additional pipeline facilities from the Texas fields through Ohio.

The company already has obtained a certificate of convenience and necessity from the Federal Power Commission for the \$22,751,550 project. New York, Chicago and Pittsburgh banks have loaned \$10,000,000 and the company proposed to take the remaining \$3,751,550 from its general funds.

The company said the new line would increase its daily rate of supply from 393,000,000 cubic feet of gas to 473,000,000.

Sentence Deferred In Driving Charge

Judge Sherman White yesterday morning sent Roger Randolph Tibbits, McLean, charged with driving while intoxicated, back to his home under a deferred sentence.

Tibbits was apprehended by Deputy Sheriff Charlie Nicholson of McLean Thursday night and was brought up for trial Saturday morning. He pleaded guilty to the charge and was ordered to return on Monday, Nov. 17 for sentencing.

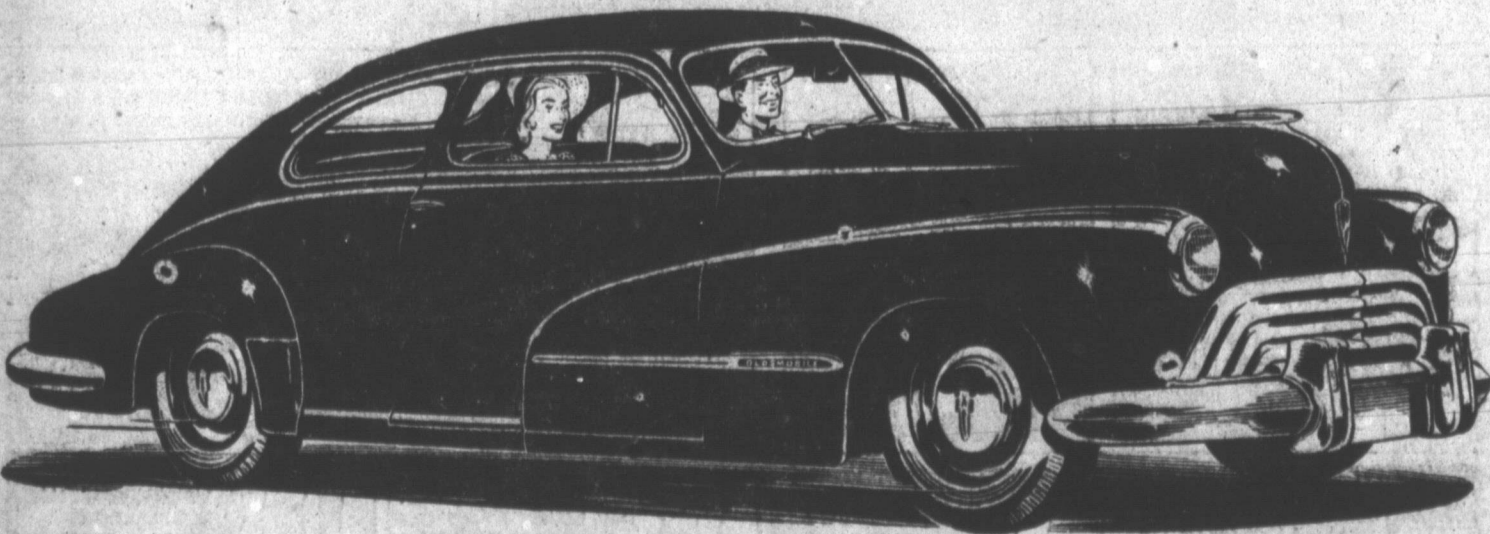
