Notes from the foreign news cables:
Common Market:
Despite commonwealth opposition, Britain will make a vigorous push for Common Market membership next month in renewed talks in Brussels.

Electric issue:
If and when Italy nationalizes its electric power companies, the right-wing opponents of the measure will scrutinize carefully the political friendship and family links of anyone given a post in the new setup. They seek to have all deputies, senators, political party officials, former legislators, and even their distant relatives barred from such offices.

Wall Street In Review

NEW YORK (UPI) — Standard & Poor's says the stock market is on a reasonably firm footing, but may face a relatively extended period of dullness and narrow price fluctuations. It thinks investor efforts at this stage should be aimed at replacing mediocre situations with more promising issues.

Borjer Trouble:
Military authorities in Seoul expect a new clash between North and South Korean soldiers facing each other across the demilitarized zone. They say the Communists are almost certain to try for revenge for the Sept. 5 beating they took from South Korean soldiers. Three North Koreans were killed after entering South Korean territory. Only one defender was wounded.

Propaganda output:
Soviet propagandists are expected to continue their barrage condemning alleged U. S. plans to include Cuba, with newspaper stories, public meetings, and radio broadcasts hammering home the theme. Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko will take the issue with him to the United Nations to continue the attacks.

Military president:
Gen. Park Chung Hee has made up his mind to run for South Korean president when civilian rule is re-established, authoritative sources in Tokyo say, but is uncertain when to announce his decision.

Presidential visit:
Pakistani President Mohammed Ayub Khan's Sept. 24th visit to the United States involves more problems than his successful trip 14 months ago. Washington is concerned about the friendly new border demarcation talks Pakistan has started with Commu-

On the occasion of the demise of "I Love Lucy" three years ago Miss Vance, who portrayed blabber-mouthed Ethel Mertz, announced loudly that video series were for the birds.

Gas Measurement Institute Scheduled In Liberal, Kans.

LAWRENCE, Kas. — A two-day Gas Measurement Institute of concentrated work and lectures on subjects and problems of the natural gas industry will be held Oct. 30-31 at the National Guard Armory in Liberal, Kansas.

Arranged through University of Kansas Extension, Southwest Center, the institute will cover subjects including safety, maintenance and fittings of orifice meters rubber plug type regulators, methods of determining specific gravity of gas, mass flow meters, back pressure testing of gas wells, automatic orifice meter chart scanner and computers, bellows meters, measurement and pressure regulators, remote supervisory control and telemetering, positive meters, hydrogen sulfide content, flame propagation and explosions, and public relations.

Program participants will be G. M. McClintock, and James B. Davis, both of Colorado Interstate Gas Co., Colorado Springs, Colo.; R. L. Matheson, Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Co., Liberal, Kans.; Hugh S. Evans, Foxboro Co., Wichita, Kas.; R. H. Welker, Textteam Corp., and Ralph Clemens, Daniel Orifice Fitting Co., both of Houston, Tex.; Garman Kimbrell, Kimray, Inc., and D. K. Bruce Jones, Northern Natural Gas Co., Liberal, Kas.; H. S. Biles, Barton Instrument Co., Monterey Park, Calif.; Charles L. Truby, Transwestern Pipeline Co., Houston, Tex.; William A. Harben, Cities Service Gas Co., Oklahoma City, Okla.; H. V. Beck, American Meter Co., and Richard E. Lembeck, Cities Service Research and Development Co., both of Tulsa, Okla.; and a Bureau of Mines representative from Dallas, Tex.

The institute is sponsored by the State Board for Vocational Education, the Southwest Kansas Petroleum Industry, the K.U. department of petroleum engineering and Southwest Center of University of Kansas Extension.

Pre-enrollment may be made through the Southwest Kansas Center in Garden City, Kansas. A \$5 fee covers the two-day institute.
