### Relative Of Pampan Named Sub Commander

Cmdr. Thomas Alan Bryce of Wichita Falls, a nephew of Mr. and Mrs. Vernon E. Moore, 501 N. Hazel, Pampa, will be commander of the nation's newest Polaris submarine, The Henry Clay SS(N) 625, which will be commissioned in ceremonies at Newport News, Va., Friday.

Cmdr. Bryce, who has visited in Pampa numerous times, formerly resided in Amarillo. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Alan T. Bryce, now reside in Wichita Falls.

Bryce and several community leaders in Wichita Falls will be present at the commissioning ceremonies set for 11:30 a.m. Friday. Sponsor will be Mrs. Green B. Gibson, a descendant of Henry Clay, for whom the new nuclear submarine is named.

Cmdr. Bryce graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1945 and was assigned to the battleship USS Nevada, which he boarded while it was in Philippine waters.

He was born in Electra.

Cmdr. Bryce commanded the submarine USS Gudgeon when it circumnavigated the globe in a 33,000-mile voyage in 1957-58.

In 1959 he became executive officer of the USS George Washington, the Navy's first fleet ballistic missile submarine.

### Pampan To Take D.R. Post With The Peace Corps

The third group of Volunteers to go to the Dominican Republic will depart for that country, Tuesday, November 27, to work in the field of rural community development.

At the present time there are 39 Peace Corps Volunteers in the Dominican Republic: 18 men and women who departed October 30 to teach English, and 21 men who have been there since July working on rural development.

The 25 Volunteers (all men) in the departing group will actually augment this first group. One of the main purposes of the project is to assist the Ministry of Agriculture to implement the Rural Development Service as a forerunner of a professional agricultural extension service. Some of the major programs planned and underway are: elementary agricultural education, reforestation, rural youth organization, agricultural cooperatives and community activities.

The Volunteers will mostly be located in the fertile Cibao Valley. They will stress the use of improved agricultural practices and techniques through extension methods.

The Volunteers were prepared for their tasks by a month of vigorous physical conditioning at the Peace Corps Camp in Puerto Rico last August. This was followed by two months of intensive training at the University of Puerto Rico studying Spanish, courses on the Dominican Republic, American studies, health, and technical studies in agricultural extension.

Now on home leave, the Volunteers will depart from New York's Idlewild Airport at 8 a.m. on November 27, Pan American Flight No. 233. They are scheduled to arrive in the capital of Santo Domingo at 11:30 a.m. on the same day.

Among those so far chosen to go is: Clayton D. Dunham, 19, of 2125 Duncan St., Pampa.

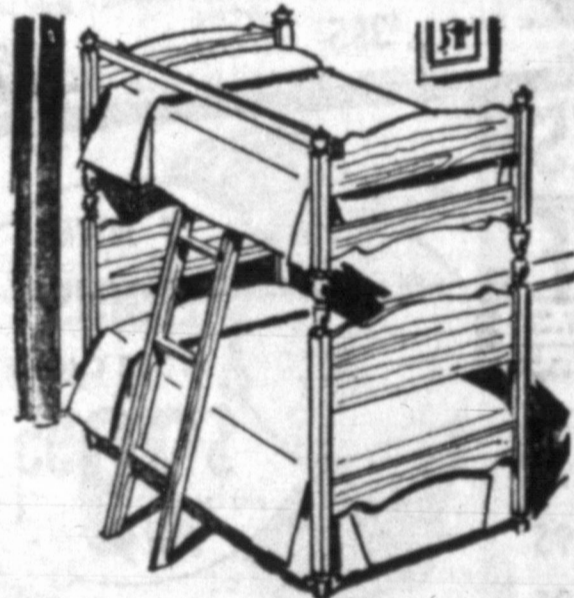

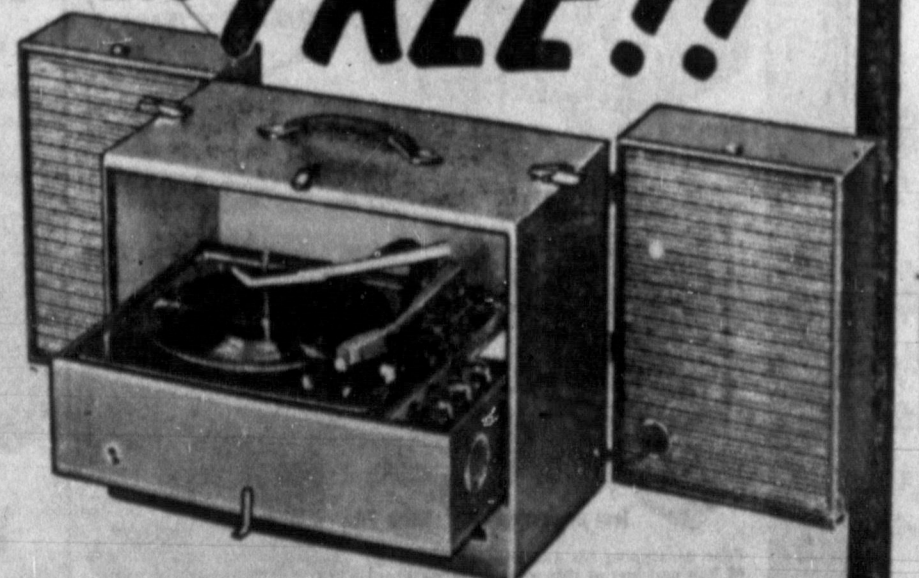

**ASK THE DESIGNER by gail dugas**

Dear Gail: I recently purchased a pink tweed Chanel type suit with three-quarter length sleeves. Would red lizard shoes and bag be suitable? (This was advised by the saleswoman.) What color and length of glove should I wear? What other color shoes and bag would be good?—E.D.

Dear E. D.: Designer Margaret Jerrold feels that shoes and bag in a dark red lizard would be handsome. She also says: "When you change your accessories, switch to shoes and bag in brown alligator, snakeskin or lizard. And with both the brown and the red accessories, the glove should be off-white or beige in a soft leather. As for length, the glove should come almost to the sleeve, leaving just a bit of bare arm."

Dear Gail: I purchased a pair of medium wine suede pumps last fall. I want to wear them again but the sides are beginning to show wear. I've brushed them about every two or three times I've worn them. I've never used a harsh stroke, just enough pressure to get them clean. I am wondering if you know of any way that I could have them fixed to look nicer. Also, what types of clothing can I wear with them? I am going to buy a new wardrobe since I am starting to work soon.—G. R. D.

Dear G. R. D.: First, advice on how to restore life to those suede shoes comes from the National Shoe Institute. These experts say:

"Dampen a lintless cloth with a little cleaning fluid and go over the shoes. Next, use the fine side of an emery board on the suede, moving the emery board in both directions. You do not say if you've been using a rubber suede brush or one with metallic bristles. The rubber suede brush is easier on the suede."

Now, as to your wardrobe: since wine suede is rather dressy and limited in its wear, I don't think you should plan a business wardrobe around these shoes. Rather, begin with two daytime dresses in wool, a good wool suit and a velvet or silk crepe dress in daylength for special occasions.

I haven't your age or description so I can't be more specific. But you'll need a new bag and shoes in black, certainly, and a half dozen pairs of gloves. Plan your hats and jewelry only after you've made other purchases.

If you're contemplating a coat, it might be an untrimmed textured wool in a vivid blue or emerald green, that can be worn exactly as basic black would be.

**Oranges Rank Favorite Fruit**

**Q—Don't more people eat apples than any other fruit?**

A—According to U.S. Department of Agriculture statistics, apples rank second, not first, in per capita consumption. Oranges are far and away the national favorite. During 1961, the average American ate 54 pounds of oranges and 26 pounds of apples. Next in popularity came bananas. We ate 22 pounds each, 18 pounds of peaches, 16 pounds of grapefruit, 12 pounds of grapes and 12 pounds of pineapples. 7 pounds of lemons and limes, and 5 pounds of pears.

**Q—Why should I give my children orange juice every day?**

A—Because oranges or orange juice, either fresh, canned or frozen, are one of the richest sources of ascorbic acid (Vitamin C). So are grapefruit and lemons. Raw strawberries, broccoli and green peppers, also. Vitamin C is needed for healthy gums and body tissues.

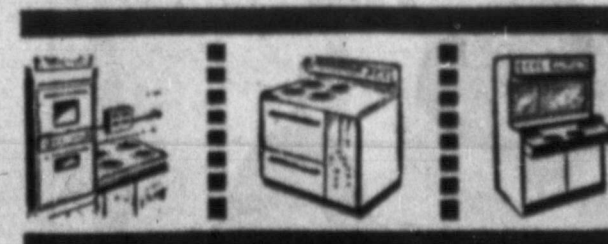

# Plan Ahead Holiday Meal

Christmas dinner should be a time of unhurried cheer, even for the homemaker. Plan a meal for 5 or 50 that to a high degree can be prepared in advance.

Select a "fully cooked" ham. Be sure you see the words "fully cooked" on the label. This means you can serve the ham cold or heat it briefly for hot service.

If the ham is to be carved hot at the table, give it a quick golden glaze. About half an hour before heating time is completed, pour the drippings off the ham. Then cover meat with brown sugar. Return ham to the oven to finish heating and set the glaze. Add whole cloves for a finishing touch, if desired.

A molded gelatin salad, spiced cranberry relish and the plum pudding for dessert are all foods to prepare the day before. Rolls and vegetables from the freezer save time too. The sweet potatoes

bake while the ham is heating. Delicious soup or fruit juice provide the appetizer course.

## Bake Delightful Cakes And Treats For Christmas Yule Date Season

Now comes the Christmas season. In many homes, that means a return to the baking oven to produce delightful holiday cakes and treats.

The following recipe for Yule Date Coffee Cake is a perfect holiday delight.

**YULE DATE COFFEE CAKE**  
 (Makes 2 coffee cakes)  
 Dough

1 cake compressed or 1 pkg. dry yeast  
 1/4 cup lukewarm water  
 1/2 cup milk, scalded  
 1/4 cup sugar  
 1 teaspoon salt  
 1-3 cup butter or margarine  
 3 to 3 1/2 cups sifted all-purpose flour

2 eggs, beaten  
 1 cup rolled oats (quick or old fashioned, uncooked)

Filling

1 cup chopped dates  
 1 cup water  
 1/2 cup sugar  
 1 tablespoon lemon juice  
 1/2 cup chopped nuts

For dough, soften yeast in lukewarm water (use warm water for

dry yeast). Pour scalded milk over sugar, salt and butter. Cool to lukewarm. Stir in 1 cup flour and eggs; add softened yeast and oats. Stir in enough more flour to make a soft dough.

Turn out on lightly floured board or canvas; knead until satiny, about 10 minutes. Round dough into ball; place in greased bowl; brush lightly with melted shortening. Cover and let rise in warm place until double in size, about 1 hour.

While dough is rising, combine filling ingredients in saucepan. Cook over low heat; stir occasionally until thickened. Cool.

Punch dough down; turn out on lightly floured board. Cover; let rest 10 minutes. Divide dough in half. Roll each half out to form a rectangle 16 x 9 inches. Spread one-half filling lengthwise down center. Cut 1-inch wide strips in dough, cutting almost to filling. Fold strips at an angle across filling, alternating sides.

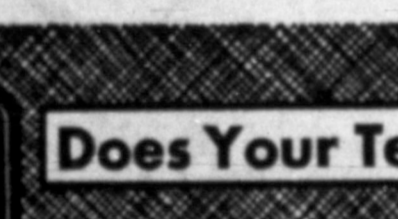
