## OFFICIAL STATEMENT

## Of The Pampa Community Nursing Care Home Campaign Executive Committee

The undersigned Citizens of Pampa, interested in the growth and development of the City and area of Gray County and the well-being of its people, both young and old, recognize a modern Nursing Care Home to be one of the great outstanding needs of this city. Appreciating our community's requirements in this respect, a committee of local citizens has been at work to ascertain how such a facility might be secured.

The Top $\mathrm{O}^{\prime}$ Texas Foundation Board of Directors, after careful investigation, engaged the Hockenbury System, Inc. of Harrisburg, Pa., to make a thorough and scientific study of the area Nursing Home situation and a detailed survey of Pampa in relation to all phases of the Nursing Home business. Analysis of this survey established the fact that there is a very definite need for a strictly modern Nursing Care Home wih a minimum of 50 beds and related services to care for long-term patients, convalescents, the chronically ill, ambulatory and bedfast, irrespective of age.

For its beginning, everyone interested in this vital project will be eternally grateful to Rev. and Mrs. E. G. Barrett for their original gift of the Mt. Zion Baptist Church property. (Another gift of $\mathbf{2 0}$ acres of land was deeded back to Rev. Berrett after a more advantageous loca tion for the Home was received.)

Their vision and recognition that the number of the aged and chronically ill in our community is steadily increasing will surely stimulate our sense of duty, obligation and responsibility to our loved ones and community leaders of days past.

The committee has studied the various means of developing such a project and has adopted what they believe
to be the most efficient and most economical plan which hey wish to place before the citizens of Pampa and area as follows:
A voluntary organization, The Top $\boldsymbol{0}^{\prime}$ Texas Foundation, has been organized under the laws of the State of Texas. It is proposed that the Nursing Home be financed on a community basis. However, the Home will be self
supporting after it is in operation.

A Nursing Home Campaign Executive Committee has been organized and a large volunteer General Solicitation organization will be formed. The work of these groups will
provide Pampa and its area with a 50 bed Nuring Care Home in keeping with its needs at an estimated cost of $\$ 300,000$.

The Citizens back of this project are Pampa business and professional men and women who believe in the future
of Pampa and its area. They are giving their time and of Pampa and its area. They are giving their time and service without compensation in this effort. Every citizen
will benefit directly and indirectly in the building of this will benefit directly and indirectly in the building of this
acility. It is, therefore, a civic privilege on the part of every eitizen to boost and contribute according to his time and means. There will be no gratuities or bonuses of any kind.

erected thereon.
(2) A community Nursing Care Home in Pampa with 50 beds will add to our City's fine area-wide reputation
and will help attract to Pampa visitors who do not stop or reside here at present.
(3) This project will be distinctly a community enterprise, meeting a definite need, which is of the greatest area, and the development of a greater unity in our city and county

(5) The Nursing Home will be equivalent to bringing an industry to Pampa employing approximately 50 people and wil have an estimated operating expense of approxiPampa; it will also become a taxpayer.
(6) Our geographic situation and conditions make this an ideal place for such a facility.
