What do they receive from it? <br> The tangible benefits of Scouting cannot be put into a dollar and cents category, but they are measurable as indicated by the following observations of a Scoutmaster 1 once knew. <br> George had a deep empathy for the boys he served and a sincere belief in the program of the Boy Scouts of America. One day I asked him if he thought the Scouting program helped boys, <br> "I remember those eager and enthusiastic Cub Scouts who came into our Scout Troop, . . | the little ones, the fat ones, the smart alecs, the timid and shy ones. And, those who had never been Cubs came in the same categories. <br> "They came to their first Scout meeting. . . a whole new world to them and slowly and timidly made their way through the door into the midst of the older Scouts. I can still remember the timid way their hands met mine in the first Scout handshake. <br> "They eagerly passed Tenderfoot requirements. They were even better at tying knots than some of the older Scouts and | they were quick to know the Scout Oath and Law. <br> How hard they tried to measure up to being like the Senior Patrol Leader. On a hike, they were out in front all the way because they wanted to be sure to keep up, but they made so much noise they missed the chance of seeing nature as it really exists. <br> All of a sudden we were holding a Troop Court of Honor and here these Scouts are, old enough to be Explorers, As they come forward for the last handshake as members of the Troop. I saw the timid, shy little Cub | Scout. He is our Senior Patrol Leader, well on his way to Eagle rank and also working for the God and Country Award. <br> He is no longer timid, shy or little. In fact, he is bigger than I am. He has become a real leader, running the meetings, offering suggestions to patrol leaders, and helping and encouraging the new Scouts. It did not happen overnight. It took a little time. But I recall the changes as they took place. He is a leader in his church and school. <br> "Ah. . here is the smart alec. . . a Patrol Leader now work- | ing for his God and Country, and a Star Scout. He took more patience at times than I ever thought I had, but gradually the meaning of the Scout Oath and Law got through to him. His patrol is the best in the troop. can be sure his patrol will finish an assigned job, be it for fun or for service. <br> "Yes, I remember how they struggled to build their first cooking fire in the wind and rain. . the noise they used to make after taps had sounded on overnight campouts. those tie in first aid training. . . and | I thought they would never learn what to do for shock, <br> "The toys they exchanged at Christmas time, they would rather have played with, but cheerfully put them in the basket for a needy family along with some food they had gathered.
