The flower stalk is ten feet high, and will shoot up twice as high before it blooms, says Mys. B. F. Wills.

This is, so far as is known the only maguey plant in Big Spring. It was brought here twelve years ago, by Mrs. F. N. Brown, now of El Paro. She probably brought it from Old Mexico, or the Big Bend country since it is a plant which thrives only in a very arid sec-tion. Mrs Jones brought two plants to Big Spring and put the other on the iawn. It was not taken care of and has long ago disappeared

This maguey is the cactus from which the Mexicans make their famous "Pulque" liquor. It is popular and well-cultivated in Old Mexico.


