



### 51 Pampa Seniors Apply For College Board Tests

Fifty-one Pampa High School seniors will find out Saturday just how ready for college they really are when they take the annual College Board entrance examination at the High School.

Mrs. Gene Fatheree, Pampa High School counselor, will administer the test to the group of seniors with Ronald Rice, math teacher, and Jim Hulitt, government teacher, as promoters.

"For the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT), 33 have applied and I expect 18 for achievement tests Saturday afternoon," Mrs. Fatheree said.

The SAT test, a general survey of English, mathematics and social studies, will be given from 8:30 a.m. to noon.

Since not all college require both parts of the College Board exam, it is divided into two parts, the SAT and the achievement tests, which will be given at 1:30 to 5:30 p.m.

Only seniors who are going to colleges that require the college board test for entrance are expected to participate Saturday.

A senior may take up to three achievement tests, which are given on every basic subject a college offers.

Students may select any three

tests or less from English composition; writing sample; foreign languages—Latin, French, German, Hebrew, Russian and Spanish; history, both American and European; standard or advanced mathematics, and science—biology, chemistry or physics.

Seniors have one more chance after Saturday to take the College Board test. It will be this summer at Amarillo College July 8, Mrs. Fatheree said.

Regular registration for the July 8 test is June 10, but after June 10, students would have to pay a \$2.50 penalty fee. Final date for guarantee of registration or changes is June 24, she said.

To apply for the July 8 test in Amarillo, students should contact Mrs. Fatheree at the high school.

### Bob Price Announces Appointment to AFA

Rep. Bob Price announced from Washington today the appointment of Randy Allen Hughes of Silverton, to the United States Air Force Academy.

Price said Hughes will enter the academy June 26 to begin cadet training. Hughes, 18, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Berton Hughes of Silverton. His appointment marks the third Panhandle youth to be named this year by Price to the Air Force Academy. The other two youths are Myron Porter, 18, of Pampa, and Bill Feeman, 18, of Sunray.

### Uvacek Finishes Cattle Marketing Class for Agents

Ed Uvacek, a livestock marketing specialist from Texas A&M University, concluded the final session here today in a two-day workshop for some 20 county agents of the Panhandle.

County agents meeting with Uvacek at the Gray County Agricultural Building east of Pampa studied seasonal variations in lamb and cattle prices today.

Uvacek said yesterday he expected to explain what causes these variations, when the bulk of calves are marketed and when most marketing demands occur.

He explained today how marketing patterns are geared to breeding programs and how these may be adjusted to increase income.

Other factors that influence prices, he said, are imports, imitation meats and competitive meat products.

He discussed the cattle carcass grading system with emphasis on new United States Department of Agriculture grades for beef.

Other topics discussed were how prices are set, what causes prices to move up or down, definitions of the cattle futures market and new techniques for forecasting cattle markets.

Workshops yesterday and today for county agents were intended to train agents in every basic phase of cattle marketing so they may meet with cattle producers in their areas and explain market procedures.

### Price Votes 'Reluctantly' For Bill

WASHINGTON (SpI) — U. S. Rep. Bob Price stated yesterday he reluctantly voted for a supplemental appropriations bill of more than \$2 billion for various agencies of the federal government.

More than one-half of the amount, Price said, was for civilian and military pay raises enacted during the last session of Congress in 1966.

The other billion dollars was also for mandatory programs provided in laws enacted before the current Congress convened.

"This is a further example of the deception of the President's budget manipulations," Price stated.

"These already known and authorized expenses were not included in last year's budget requests but were deferred until after last year's elections.

"Neither did last year's budget requests include some \$14 billion for the costs of the war in Vietnam, which this Congress also had to appropriate.

"This is money that will be added to the 1967 fiscal-year budget deficit, which the President said before the election last November would be less than \$2 billion, but is now estimated at close to \$10 billion," Price added.

### Council to Fight 'Further Erosion' of Taft-Hartley

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — An all-out campaign to prevent organized labor from legalizing "common situs" picketing by diluting the Taft-Hartley Law has been pledged by the Southern States Industrial Council.

"This type of picketing—really a secondary boycott—would permit labor leaders to enslave contractor and worker alike at virtually any construction project in the county," said J. Clifford Miller, Jr., of Richmond, Va., a manufacturer and chairman of the Council's legislative committee.

"We have over 2,200 corporate members concentrated in 16

southern states and strong representation nationally," Miller added. "We intend to be heard in this matter!" In communications to the Council's membership, made up of conservative business and professional leaders, Miller pointed out the dangers inherent in organized labor's current strategy.

"Every American has a stake in this fight," said Miller. "The construction industry is basic to our total national well-being. We must not let it be chained and handed over as bound captive to the arrogance of unscrupulous labor bosses seeking personal power."

Section 8 (b) (4) (B) of the Taft-Hartley Law restricts picketing at construction sites from entirely abridging the rights of those not party to a dispute between a union and a contractor or sub-contractor, according to Miller. Efforts by organized labor to strike down this protective clause have been continuous for fifteen years. If successful, said Miller, "Powerful unions could picket for any purpose, including that of compelling any—or all contractors—to suspend work while the unions, bring any reluctant job-site employer to terms, thereby

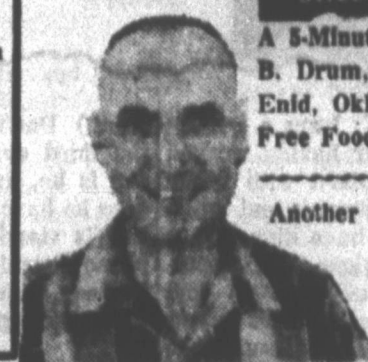

# Special Dinner Insures Mom Her Day Free From Kitchen

Whether dinner BY mother or FOR mother on her day, a menu both special and easy is in order. A butter-basted two pound turkey roast fills these requirements deliciously. If the youngsters take over kitchen duty to honor mother, the turkey roast is simple to prepare. It cooks in the oven for two hrs. without special attention. The basting is built into the roast. In families with small tots and mother cooks dinner herself, she will appreciate the same convenience which gives her more time out of the kitchen.

The balance of the meal should be simple too. Baked potatoes are a natural. They go into the oven during the final hour the turkey roast cooks. Tomato tulips brighten the salad course when stuffed with coleslaw. Or, if daughter knows her way around the kitchen, she may want to serve the tomato tulips hot filled with a mushroom cheese stuffing. The coleslaw would then be served separately.

For dessert give mother her favorite flavor of ice cream. Perhaps she will choose party peach ice cream or delicate apricot sherbet. There are plenty of other days in the year to serve chocolate or strawberry. Butter cookie: either home baked or from a package are the finishing touch.

**TURKEY ROAST**  
with  
**MUSHROOM-STUFFED TOMATOES**  
(Yield: 6 servings)  
2 lb. turkey roast, butter basted  
4 ounces fresh mushrooms  
3 tablespoons butter  
3 tablespoons chopped onions  
3 tablespoons flour  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
1 cup milk  
6 medium, firm tomatoes  
6 tablespoons shredded Cheddar cheese

Roast turkey according to directions on package. Clean mushrooms and chop fine. Melt butter in a heavy skillet. Saute mushrooms and onion until tender. Blend in flour, salt, and

pepper. Stir in milk gradually. Cook over low heat until thickened, stirring occasionally.

Wash tomatoes and cut off tops. Scoop out centers. Sprinkle insides with salt and pepper. Fill each tomato with creamed mushrooms. Place tomatoes in Sprinkle 1 tablespoon of shredded cheese over each tomato. Bake in a hot oven 8 to 10 minutes.

Pack some thumb-tacks with the picnic fixings. Use to hold tablecloth, paper plates when there is a wind.

Bake potatoes in a muffin pan. They will not move around and will be easy to remove from the oven.
