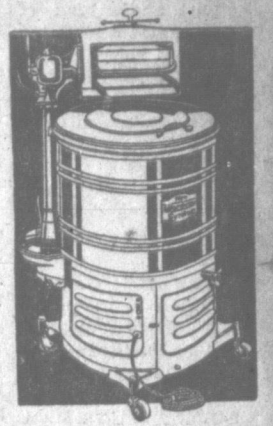

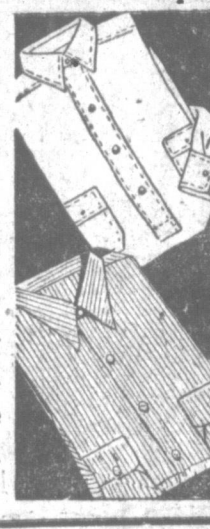

# DENOUNCES STERLING!

Mike Hogg, brilliant son of the great "Commoner," James Stephen Hogg, probably the most distinguished Governor Texas ever had, true to the principles of his illustrious father, denounced the stupendous expenditure of money for and by R. S. Sterling, candidate for governor, in the following withering words:

"I wish to warn the people of Texas that never before has this state been in as much danger as it is today. There is arrayed against it the most outlandish press propaganda that was ever instituted. Censorship in favor of R. S. Sterling and against all other candidates is as strict as was the censorship in the A. E. F. when the boys were writing back home. The big dailies—most of them—and a majority of the small papers outrageously warp facts and figures and the people are being misled with all the power there is in the press. "Doctrines that are as dangerous as they are demagogic are being preached by men who have never done one thing for Texas in a crisis.

"Promises that can never be fulfilled are being made. Offers to return money to counties and to lower taxes are being made in exchange for votes.

"The country press is being flooded with cashier's checks for advertising and for editorials.

"Great dailies, that are being run by the business office and not by editors, are putting forth the propaganda of big business.

"It is an orgy of wealth run wild, in behalf of a candidate who has never delivered one constructive idea in behalf of Texas in any speech he has made."

This statement was issued just prior to the first primary and stands as a damning indictment on the attempt of "Standard Oil Sterling"—as he has been called by some—and his plutocratic partisans to buy the governors office.

### Can Texas Be Bought or Forced to Elect Sterling Governor?

The El Paso Post, a supporter of Jim Young for governor, recently carried the following as a front page editorial. Regarding Sterling's candidacy the editorial said:

"At the beginning of this last week of the gubernatorial campaign, a telephone call came in from Abilene which, in substance, was something like this: 'Sentiment for Sterling is sweeping the state like wildfire. He's sure to be in runoff, and, subsequently, nominated for governor. He's still chairman of the highway commission. You people out there have got big road allotments. You expect to get more. But, up to now, you've done nothing for Sterling; you're twiddling your thumbs while other candidates win your county; you're going to be out in the cold. Now, if you expect any more road money, from this administration or the next, you'd better get busy.

"And local 'pork barrel' politicians and band wagon climbers immediately got busy.

"This flagrant use of the public patronage club is a perfect demonstration of the dangers of which Jim Young warned when, the day after Sterling announced for governor and for many days thereafter, Young demanded that Sterling resign from the highway commission.

"If Clint Small gets nothing more out of the campaign than the fame of having flung this shaft, he'll be remembered long in Texas politics: 'Strip Sterling of his purple robes as chairman of the highway commission, take away his 5000 campaign managers on the state's payroll, whistle him down to the financial size of the rest of us candidates and make him run on his own merits, and he wouldn't get as many votes as Soapy Moody.

"How does the Post know this patronage club was brought into play? Because an emissary of the newly formed Sterling club tried to use it on the Post's editor, to force him to flop from Jim Young.

"But, in the Post's opinion, this frantic, last-minute grab for possibly fading administration favors will be futile.

"The Post still hopes that Sterling's apparent gains are no more than surface indications reflected from his lavish expenditure of money. And, even if he gets into the run-off, an adroit, fire-eating campaign such as Jim Ferguson can make could defeat him.

"The Post can't believe, yet, that the voters of Texas will permit a multi-millionaire with neither ability nor training for state affairs, to buy and club his way into the governor's mansion."

There is a deliberate attempt being made by the Special Predatory Interests of Texas, aided and abetted by the partisan and prejudiced supporters of R. S. Sterling, to buy enough votes to nominate Sterling for governor. And, if they cannot buy enough votes, then the tremendous powers of the Highway Commission is to be used to coerce, cajole and force his nomination by the withholding of state aid for roads in the counties that may be bold enough to oppose his candidacy.

Citizens of Texas, are you going to be bought? Are you going to bow down to the Dictator? Are you going to be driven like slaves? Are you going to tremble like a cringing coward and vote for Sterling for governor? We do not believe you will. We fully believe you will stand four-square as red-blooded Texans should and defy the Special Interests, defy Standard Oil, defy the glittering gold of Jesse Jones and R. S. Sterling, and vote for the best interest of Texas, by casting your vote and using your influence for that outstanding and estimable lady, that friend of humanity and protector of the poor—
