YOUTH IS GIVEN DEATH SENTENCE

HONDO, July 10. (AP) — John L. Green, 17-year-old negro boy, who confessed Friday to the murder of Frank Kempf, Devine dairyman, was sentenced by a jury to die in the electric chair. The verdict was brought in at 10 o'clock tonight.

Green entered a plea of guilty in a long recitation on the stand before the jury and the afternoon session of the court was taken up by arguments by prosecution and defense counsel. The judge then delivered his charge to the jury, which took the case at 5 p.m.

Ernest Johnson, 20, another negro charged with Kempf's murder, will be tried Monday, it was announced.

Four Are Charged With Possession

Charges of possession for the purpose of sale of beer, the same being intoxicating malt, were filed against four Pampans last night before Justice of the Peace W. S. Baxter. The raids, which netted large quantities of beer and equipment, were made by officers of the sheriff's and constable's departments, and city officers.

A. C. Speery was released on bond of \$1,000 to appear this morning at 10 o'clock for an examining trial. Geo. Walters, arrested with Speery, is still in jail. The officers confiscated 392 bottles of beer, a number of empty bottles and several cans of malt.

Mrs. Irene Mathis was charged with the same offense last night when officers raided a place and found a quantity of beer and empty bottles. Mrs. Beula Mae Brydges was also charged with the same offense and released on bond.

Jury Dismissed In Murder Case

HOUSTON, July 10. (AP) — The murder trial of Donald E. Covin, 23-year-old former Beaumont bellboy, ended this afternoon with the discharge of a "hung" jury. No date for the retrial was set. The jury had been out 48 hours.

Youths Arrested In Motor Theft

LONGVIEW, July 10. (AP) — Less than two hours after Otis Warren, taxicab driver, broke his bonds and hurried eight miles to report how two men had forced him to drive them into a lonely sector, and had robbed him in broad daylight, two youths were arrested in Greenville, 197 miles away.

Warren told officers the men forced him at gun points to drive them out the Gladewater highway, and thence into an unfrequented section, where he was robbed of a small amount of money, and left bound hand and foot. A roll of bills which he carried was overlooked. The men then drove away in Warren's car.

Doyle Is Elected Cashier of Bank

W. H. Doyle, former Pampa resident, has been elected cashier of the Farmers State Bank at Scottsdale, Ariz., according to word received here. Mr. Doyle was cashier with the Pampa National bank during his four-year residence in Pampa.

While in Pampa Mr. Doyle was active in social and chamber of commerce work. He also had oil interests here.

Sharpe claimed the other negro hit him on the head from behind and that he grabbed the nearest weapon handy and "took after him." After being placed in jail Sharpe asked Sheriff Blanset where the other "nigger" was, and why he

wasn't in jail. When informed that Dismuke's hand was nearly covered, Sharpe remarked, "Did ah jes' git his hand? Ah sho' meant to git dat nigger's hand. He slipped up behind me in the dark wid a hatchet," he claimed.
