ON GAS TAXES.
Sam Braswell in the Clarendon News:
The attention of the legislature is being directed to the fact that 81 per cent of the present natural gas production of Texas is being consumed outside of Texas, with

only \$120,000 of revenue to the state, that amount being paid as a 2 per cent gross production tax. A new measure has been introduced which would place a tax of 2 cents on each 1000 cubic feet of natural gas produced, but allowing each producing company an exemption on the first 150 million cubic feet each three months. The purpose, of course, is to exempt Texas users of gas from tax. Such a measure, consumed outside of Texas, with

only \$120,000 of revenue to the state, that amount being paid as a 2 per cent gross production tax. COW TESTING VITAL.
T. A. Landers in McLean News:
Canyon dairy cows were tested last week, and while no T.B. was

found in the regular dairy herds that are tested regularly, two cases were found in the 36 other cows in town; also two cases being found in farm cows tested. The cost of testing is so small and the danger of disease so great that all milk users should see that their milk comes from tested cows.

(We know of no food which should be more closely regulated than milk. It is an essential food, vital to children but no less important to adults. Contented cows are more vital than one might think. By contented we mean healthy, free from T.B. or other contagious infections. It matters much, too, especially in the warm seasons how sanitation is observed. Inspections are necessary. Without them, fair competition is impossible and it is impossible to maintain a standard of purity and quality. Any good dairyman will tell you as much.)

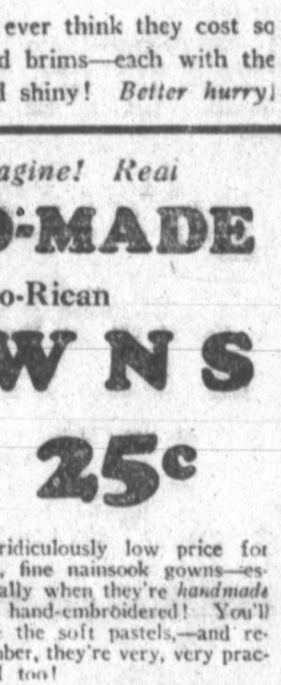
