 Deportation of Alien CriminalsCivic elubmen are Deporvation of Alien Criminals
Civic elubmen are beginning to take notice of U. S.
deportation laws and the abuses which surround them.
Incredibly cruel family separations are noted on one incredibly cruel family separations are noted, on one
hand, in contrast to political racketeering on the other.
Under existing law, any judge or even police court
magistrate can avert the deportation of a magistrate can avert the deportation of an alien crim-
inal, but not even the President of the United States
can prevent deportation of an alien who is can prevent deportation of an alien who is of good char
acter. A proposed new law would provide for limited
discretion in staying deportation of aliens, of good character who have been in this country 10 years or have
members of their immediate families here as citizens.
It would make it possible to deport for one crime inresidence; render racketeers and gangsters convicted of
carrying, dangerous weapons subject to deportation;
subject the violator of state narcotic laws to deport tion on the same terme as violators of federal acts; make
the alien who \&muggles other aliens into the country
denortable deportable the present law enables the deportation of
the alien who enters illegally but does not permit de-
portation of the alien smuggler. Immigration to this country has dropped from more
than a million a year to between 30,00 and 40,00 a year. For several years, more persons of foreign birth have
returned to their native lands than have come here as immigrants. The alien, contrary to popular opinion, is
no more a menace to our form of government than are have Americans. A few hundred atiens of criminal fame
have given the illusion of this condition. There are 000 have directly or through their parents applied fo nsturalization, There are about 100,000 subject to de
portation for illegal entry or other causes. Alient seamen numbering from 250 a year upward, enter this country
illegally and about half of them remain. About 289,000 Mexicans have no legal right to live in this country.
In the administration of the immigration laws, how ever, there is found to be a tendency of political group
to coddle the alien criminal, yet deal with severity with the alien of good character. Husbands are being torn
from their American-citizen wiyes and children. Often the husband is deported to one cquntry, the wife to an-
otother, and the children to a third-separating them are barbarous and un-A merican, unworthy of a humane
nation. If the law is not changed, 7,000 husbands must taken from their American-citizen husbands.
