The Eagles quarterback saved the team's season with a 28 -yard pass to Freddie Mitchell on fourth-and-26 that
led to David Akers' field goal that tied it with 5 seconds left in regulation on Sunday.
Akers eventually won it with a 31 yard kick less than five minutes into overtime, giving the Eagles a 20-17 victory over the Green Bay Packers. That sent Philadelphia (13-4) into its third straight

Carolina Carolina.
"Donovan has been our leader. We have stuck behind him in thick and thin
and that shows his character," Mitchell said. "This all stems from Donovan McNabb."

McNabb was sacked eight times and completed just one of his first seven pass attempts, but ended up rushing for 107 yards - a playoff record for quarterbacks. He was 21 -of- 39 for 248 yards passing and credited everyone but himpassing
