The major difference in 1969 new car warranties lies in the length of time most parts (excluding tires and tubes) are covered. New provisions call for 12 -month or 12,000 mile coverage. In 1968, the warranty called for two-year or 24,000 miles.
Still intact is the five-year or $50,000-\mathrm{mile}$ protection on components generally referred o as the drive train. (Items like internal engine parts, transmission, rear axle and differential.)
To protect their warranties, motorists nust do the following: -Change engine oil and oil filter and clean the filler cap at periods specified by the manufacturer. (Typically, every six months or 6,000 miles.)
-Clean the carburetor air filter and replace it at specified intervals. (Usually, six months or 6.000 miles for cleaning; 24 months or 24,000 miles for replacing an eight-cylinder engine -12 months or 12,000 miles for six-cylinder engines.) One such item is tune-up in- Wiper following: YEAB
