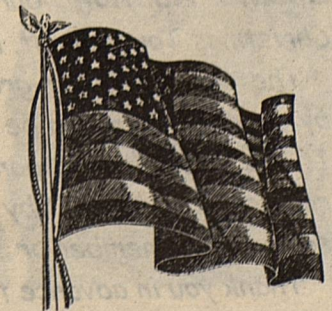

# Coyotes and Lady Coyotes spend time on the road and in gymnasiums

## Coahoma Tournament results

For most high school athletes these days, their social lives revolve around a gymnasium.

Last week was no exception as Borden High School students had a Tuesday night game in Meadow. Their road trips continued Thursday, Friday, and Saturday as they saw action in the annual Coahoma Tournament.

In Meadow, the girls' game was one of extremes: excessive offense and defense combined with runs of cold-shooting and fouls.

Meadow took a 13-8 lead after the first period of play, but the Lady Coyotes went on a 13-0 run to lead at half-time 21-19.

Meadow stormed back to score 12 points to the Lady Coyotes' four and led going into the final quarter, 31-27.

In the midst of this tight game, BHS fouled out three players, including two starters. With 3:22 remaining in the game, Meadow had a five-point lead and was riding momentum after another Lady Coyote fouled out.

Hustle and some great bench help from Carolina Arellanos, who came in and had two steals, put

BHS back in the game.

With five seconds remaining, junior Rika Copeland hit an inside shot to break the 41-41 tie and give the Lady Coyotes their 43-41 victory.

The boys faced an experienced Meadow team with depth to go along.

Meadow scored the first eight points of the game before sophomore Talin Pepper connected on a 10-foot jump shot to get the Coyotes on the board.

Talin's jumper at the end of the period, along with two free throws (one by Talin, one by Rowdy Dunlap), were the only points BHS could garner by the end of the first period as they trailed, 17-6.

Second-quarter action produced more offense as the Coyotes made 16 points, 12 of those coming on a four of four performance from the three-point line.

Senior Trent Pepper hit one of those, while Talin nailed two and freshman Evan Winegarner found the mark for the other 3-pointer. Meadow's lead at half-time was 43-22.

Cold shooting plagued the Coyotes the entire second half as they could only manage 2-11 from the

field and 3-7 from the free-throw line.

The Coyotes did manage 26 rebounds in the contest, 19 of those defensive boards.

Meadow took the win, 81-32.

## TOURNAMENT ACTION

At Coahoma over the weekend, both boys and girls were involved in

several games.

The girls finished the tournament with a 2-2 mark, defeating district rival Ira, 47-42, and AAAA school Ft. Stockton, 53-43.

Their losses were to Lubbock-Cooper, 64-55, and the consolation match with host Coahoma, 46-39.

The boys met Hawley in first-round action, losing 57-24. They then fell to Coahoma, 57-29, and Seminole JV, 71-27.

Named to the All-Tournament team was Bekah Hensley, the lone senior on this year's Lady Coyote team.
