shedding. shedding
First, he says. sice an extra piece off the bottom of three weeks may elapse bel ween the time the tree is
chopped down and the day you take it home. In that
period. the "wound" at the base has healed and the tree cannot absorb water unless you make a new cut. Second, give the tree plenty of water. Because it has been dry for a long period, the tree may "drink" up to
three quarts of water the first day, Koch said. Never

The luxury of a two-story home was not known in Wichita until 1869 when the Munger house was built with the assistance of family and friends. This is probably the most notable of the original Cotton. <br> Cottonwood logs hewn with axes and arzes were squared for walls, subfloors and a base for the shake roof. The river nearby provided materials for the mortar clam shells with sand and water - which contained buffalo hair to make it cohesive. <br> In contrast, the parsonage is a refined frame cottage with an ornate iron fence. The three-room structure is conservatively furnished with the exception of a fine parlor |
