## REV. HUBERT BRATCHER <br> FIRST METHODIST CHURCH <br> DANGER AHEAD - MARRIAGE

Dr. Halford Luccock points out in his book "unfinished business" that rushing from one service to another, a minister is likely, on occasion, to confuse one part of the ritual with another . . . weddings, funerals, church membership One may start out on the marriage service by quoting the opening of the burial service
The more I counsel with married people the more I can see something worth thinking about in this ritualistic mistake. For it may picture a common sort of tragedy. Marriage may be a sort of burial, in which parties may be laid away, as far as any deep, vital interest in life is concerned or the personality of one may be "swallowed-up" by the personality of the other. "Forasmuch as John and Mary have consented together in holy wedlock we consign their bodies to selfish concern, without windows on the world." For what starts out a "honeymoon cottage" may become a prison for the spirit
Another danger of marriage is that it may fall into the grave of believing that the whole of life consists in THINGS. There are so many things that a home needs. and the list grows daily! Nothing down and no payments until February!!! Thus their world can become a world of "thing-full emptiness." Then we may ask, "what shall it profit a man and a woman to get a house full of gadgets and lose their own lives?"
A third danger ahead in marriage is that the children in the home, instead of increasing the interest of parents in ALL children, will lead them to believe that they are the only children in the world.

If these solemn vows be kept inviolate, and if steadfastly you endeavor to do the will of your Heavenly Father, your life will be full of joy and the home which you are establishing will abide in peace.
