under federal supervision. the college can remain open and the government can get the $\$ 2.8$ million it says

But coliege administrators have disputed that figure. and rustee Chairman J.K. Haynes said HEW owed

The trio was indicted again in July on seven counts of emberzling money sent to the college for ferderal
programs and making false statements as to the use of

Furniture design professio sees an increase of women Why is it that women with a flair for design and who know how to
draw frequently pursue careers as interior decorators but rarely aspire to the role of furniture designer? aspire to the reve of furniture designer?
"Furniture designing has always been a man's profession, perhaps mechanics." says Elyse Lacher, one of today's few successful, woman furniture designers.
"But. a woman's s designs can often be superior to a man's. because
