Metzer, cotton spe cialist for the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. certincation label will tell ther what variety the seed is, and the analyses label will provide in formation on quality factors." Both labels tell the complete story about the seed, but keep in mind that quality factors can certified," notes Metzer.

SEED CERT. CONT
Certification for genetic identity means that seed has been produced and processed under standards and procedures estab ished by the Texas Seed and Plant Board and enforced by the Texas Department of Agriculture to assure that the variety is as repcesented by the certification label accompanying the seed.

Reading the label has always been of importance in purchasing seed, but the new standard will place even greater respon sibility on the producer to care ully read both labels to deter mine if the seed meets his quality requirements." points out Metzer.
