Cleanup begins as flooding moves south

| The rain-swollen Lavaca and Guadalupe rivers chased South Texans to higher ground for a second day as they churned over their banks downstream from where floodwaters claimed the lives of at least five people. <br> In Cuero; the steadily rising Guadelupe River Tuesday flooded parts of the city about 80 miles southeast of San Antonio. <br> The National Weather Service said the Guadalupe River had fallen to 41.5 feet at Cuero - early today. The river is at or near crest and should remain at or near 41.5 feet today. <br> At Victoria, the Guadalupe reached 30 feet early today and was expected to crest at 30.5 feet sometime Thursday. <br> Most of the heavy rainfall had ended before dawn today, but forecasters said the flooding would continue for some time. <br> A "Several river additions are completely under water." said Dewitt County Sheriff Bob McMahan. "And some livestock have been lost down the river." No injuries were reported and residents were warned in time to evacuate their homes and save most of their property, officials said. <br> Rampaging floods, triggered by a tropical depression that dumped up to 18 inches of rain over parts of South Texas, claimed five lives Monday. including three teen-age brothers. Hundreds of evacuated residents in Gonzales and |
