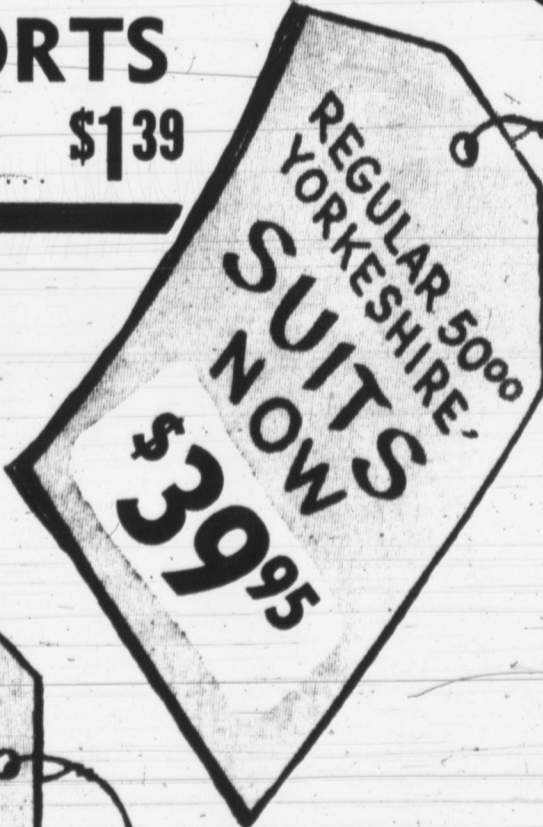

Gadgets, Some Unusual, Others Common, Keep Candidates' Names Before Voting Public

 Although candidates for local offices have been talking little and saying less, their campaign gadgets are novel but useful in most instances.

The newest wrinkle was pulled by District Judge Lewis M. Goodrich who is giving out regular sized pencils emblazoned with the simple plea, "re-elect Goodrich as district judge." Some are expecting his opponent, H. B. Hill, to come out with pocket pencil sharpeners.

On the stunt side Hill has borrowed the singing commercial with a musical ditty over the radio instead of spot announcements. The words and music are reported to be original.

Bookmatch warfare reached a new high this year and was kicked off first by sheriff-hopeful, Rufe Jordan using a light green cover with embossed aluminum lettering. It was only a matter of days before his opponent, Sheriff G. H. Kyle, blossomed out with similar bookmatches in varied hues but with the identical embossed aluminum lettering. The veteran sheriff ordered also several thousand emory fingerboards with his political advertisement spread over the top side.

But the bookmatch battle didn't end with the first Kyle-Jordan tussle. Jordan countered with an imitation gold leaf cover under plain black lettering. In the meantime candidates for other offices were putting out bookmatches with colored pictures and safety slogans on the back, and their advertisements on the front. In the early days of the campaign the bookmatches were dull until congressional candidate Walter Rogers started putting his picture on the back. Several other

run of the mill stuff with the possible exception of Precinct 2 County Commissioner Bill Graham who has taken to the U.S. Mails with penny postcards and a short message printed on the message side of the card.

Outside of the barbecue given for Walter Rogers during the special May 6 congressional race by Sheriff Kyle, and several businessmen, there have been no political clambakes for the voters. How good an investment the candidates have made in their gadgets and catchy advertising stunts will be weighed against the votes they receive on July 22.

The most attractive, and useful, hand card is being employed by F. E. Leech, unopposed in his county tax assessor-collector's post. The long-time tax collector uses a white card with embossed blue lettering entwined with the embossed red outline of a donkey, symbol of the Democratic party. On the reverse side of the card is the home schedule of the Pampa Oilers.

Car-window posters — for use on windshields or rear and side windows — was launched early in the race by Bill Waters, seeking the county attorneyship. Waters is waging a vigorous campaign for the county court prosecuting berth. He is also using the regular name card, window posters and picture bookmatches. He also plans to take to the airways later in the campaign.

Waters' opponent, incumbent John Studer, was also reported by KPLN as purchasing radio time.

Director Awaiting Jury Decision on Wife's Shooting

CARMEL, N.Y. — (AP) — Herbert Gehr, 39-year-old photographer and television director, waited today in the Putnam County jail for a grand jury to weigh the charge that he murdered his wife.

State police said the shooting took place early yesterday morning when Gehr's wife, Andrea, trapped him in a secluded cottage with another woman. Gehr, firing into the darkness with a 22 rifle, shot his 30-year-old wife between the eyes as she stood outside the cottage door.

She was leading four private detectives and a photographer on a raid seeking evidence for a divorce from the ABC television director.

Gehr, who said later he thought they were trying to force their way into the cottage, fired a second shot that nicked two of the detectives.

The five men fled, leaving Mrs. Gehr's body where it fell.

Gehr called police, rallied his companion — 31-year-old Mrs. Dorothea Matthews, who had run into the woods — naked — and then fled with her in his car after she recovered part of her clothes.

They were arrested without resistance at a police road-block 32 miles away. Gehr was arraigned for first degree murder.

Mrs. Matthews, who was so upset that she had fled without her undergarments, was released.

Police Inform Man He's Theft Victim

PHILADELPHIA — (AP) — Wilfred Whitehead was the victim of a \$25,000 theft but he didn't know it until police telephoned him to come and get his stolen securities.

The discovery came when Mrs. Emma Wilson found the securities in her home. She didn't know how they got there.

Detectives, questioning Mrs. Wilson's young son, learned he and three neighborhood playmates had broken into Whitehead's home and taken the securities.

The boys, ranging in age from 12 to 14, were charged with burglary yesterday.

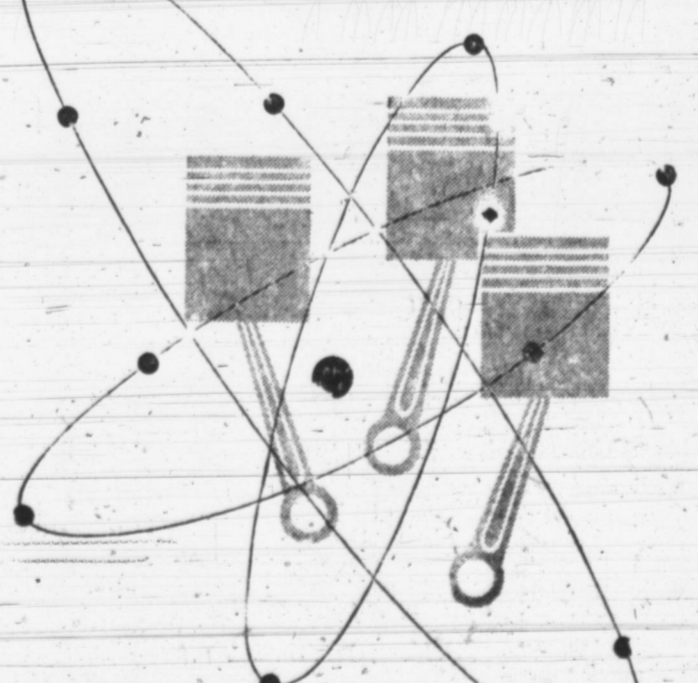
Former Marine Sues for Divorce

Berquist, Chicago packer, has sued him for divorce. She charges Booser drank excessively. They were married two years ago in Las-Vegas, Nev.
