this Lenox service, President Wilson found the answef to a search that had begun in 1826. In that year, Congress passed o law requiring that, as for as possible, all equipment for the President's home be made in Americo. Succeeding Presidents sought diligently but had to compromise with imported china. Thot's why, when Woodrow Wilson introduced Lenox to the White House, Washington hostesses blinked with surprise, Was there any such thing as "fine American chino"? There was! The great beauty and amazing durability of the Lenox service wos proof. In fact, only four pieces of this 1,700 piece set were broken in an eight-year period!

resident Franklin D. Roosevelt, too, commissioned Lenox to create an official service, which is' used in the White House today. Here, the President's design deas were more positive. 7he plate pictured above is the dinner plate of the President Wilson service. Since Woodrow Wilson's administration, Lenox has been the official White House china. Lenox was re-ordered by Franklin Roosevelt in 1932 for the Presidential service. The center circle and border are 24 -k. etched gold, the latter having 48 stars. The President's seal has been done in raised gold on an ivory border. The strict formality of the pattern was typical of the services of that period.

One of the most interesting might come from the Lenox chino that解 mendous heat, but the shape is the same and the body of the ware is as good as the day it was made! To return to present times, in 1939 it was imperative that a special fine china ervice be created for the use of King George Vi and Queen Elizobeth of England during their visit to the United States, Lenox was again called in, and designed the famous ser vice of 48 golden stars on a lustrous ivory background. This beautiful service was kept thereafter in the Federal Building at the World's Fair for the exclusive use of visiting dig_ nitaries.

te Governors have been one of the largest groups requesting special services of Lenox China. Governor Hoffman was so pleased with his official pattern of the New Jersey State Seal in $24-\mathrm{k}$ gold against a deep cobalt blue border, that he ordered 47 extro plates to be sent as gifts to each of the other governors!
