Q $=$ Are City Sales Tax Payments Deductible From Our Federal Income Tax?
A = The Sales Tax cannot be deducted from your income tax unless you itemize your return. The average working man does not itemize. He uses the standard short form. Therefore the money he spends for the lc Sales Tax is of no benefit to him as a deducare paid by his tenants, usually does itemize his return - thereby gaining the double benefit of claiming the property tax deduction, and the deduction on the le sales tax. Q $=$ = There Is A $2 \%$ State Tax On Automobiles. Would The City Tax Also Apply To Automobile Sales?
$A$ No - BUT - The Tax does apply to all replacement parts and ac-

Q=Is Is The City Sales Tax Regressive-That Is Will It Cause A Particular Hardship On Lower-Income Families?
Yes - the lowest income family will spend a greater portion of the income for taxable necessities, such as clothing, shoes, furniture,
bedding, personal items, etc.
$Q=-$ Why is There A Need For So Much Money?
A Necessities, such as paying Marvin Springer $\$ 33,000$ for advice and recommendations on City Planning, which we have been told by city hall spokesmen, cannot be used for at least 10 years; the
total absence of efficiency in City Administration.
