Control Mesquite With Chemicals
According to Geo. Sealy According to Geo. Sealy,
county agent, during the past few years about million acres of mesquite infested Texas rangeland has been sprayed with chemicals. Results generally have been fair to good considering it as a control measure and not as complete eradication. Aerial spraying is the most ial spraying is the most popular and practical meth-
od for applying the chemipop for
cals.

He states that recent re-
search findings at the Spu Experiment Station shows that one-half to two-thirds of a pound of low volatile ester 2,4,5-T applied in an emulsion of one gallon of diesel oil and three gallons of water will give good results. He also points out that chemical applications will give good control for a ew years but will not eradicate the mesquite on the
Sealy states that an acr
of average mesquite infested range land is tapped daily of about 50 gallons of water. That loss is the amount given off by the

## mesqui. ation.

When moisture is problem, he explains, th ass gets little attention but when dry the gress tha might have been produced with the 70 to 75 tons water loss per acre yearly would mean a great deal the plans of ranchmen.
Mesquite takes from three to four times mor water to produce one pound of leaves or beans than is required for a pound of buffalo grass or side oat grama. He cites figures released by the Spur Experiment Station to show the value of clearing brush
from range land. Beef catfrom range land. Beef cat
tle on the brush cleared pastures produced 35.6 pounds of beef an acre against 23.2 pounds an acre from non cleared pastures. The condition of the mes quite growth at the time the spray is applied has strong bearing upon th final results. Generally the proper time for making the chemical application is during the heavy leaf stage usually from 40 to 90 days after the mesquite leaf out in the spring accompanied with good soil moisture conditions and a vigorous plant growth.
