





NO. 4—THE LEGISLATOR Old State House, completed in 1853, is replete with Lincoln memories. Here the Twelfth General Assembly, of which he was a member, held its last session in 1840-1841. In his Supreme Court chambers he argued some 200 cases, and in the House of Representatives, he delivered one of his most profound speeches in reply to Stephen A. Douglas. Here in June, 1858, Lincoln delivered his famous "House Divided" speech. On May 3 and 4, 1865, the body of Lincoln lay here in state while a silent throng passed in final homage to their fellow townsman.

(Continued from page one) Strategy for stepping up pressure on Red China to end the Korean war. Sen. Karl E. Mundt (R-S.D.) joined the rank of farm state senators demanding that Secretary of Agriculture Ezra T. Benson take immediate steps to cope with falling farm prices. Mundt asked Benson to publicly assure farmers the government will take "positive steps" to aid them. Some GOP congressmen, after waiting 20 years for a chance to become postmasters, learned that they have to let their patronage plums fall to Democrats. Civil Service rules limit the choice of a postmaster to the top three applicants in a competitive examination and in some Republican districts, all three eligibles are Democrats.

B-29s Wreck Supply Center

SEOUL, Feb. 9—UP—B-29 pilots said Monday they left a B-29 crewed by "cracked and smoking" in an attack in which they dropped 220,000 pounds of bombs on 150 buildings and supply stacks. The target for Sunday night's raid was about eight miles southwest of the North Korean capital. Eleven B-29s flew through the coldest temperatures of the year—45 degrees below zero—to carry out the huge attack.

Four Die In Plane Crash

SAN ANTONIO, Feb. 9—UP—State police reported Monday that four persons were killed in a plane crash near Bulverde, Tex., 20 miles north of San Antonio. The plane was reported to be a Beechcraft Bonanza. The names of the victims were not learned immediately.

Army Colonel Goes On Trial

FT. MEADE, Md., Feb. 9—UP—Lt. Col. Melvin B. Voorhees, former censor in Korea, went on trial Monday on charges of publishing a book about the Korean war without first submitting it to Army censorship. A court martial board of nine colonels and two lieutenant colonels was convened to hear the charges against the reserve officer who is accused of violating Army regulations and disobeying a superior officer's command.

Life Sentence For Mrs. Smith

TOKYO, Feb. 9—UP—The Tokyo post commander of the U.S. Army formally approved Monday a life imprisonment sentence imposed on Mrs. Dorothy Smith for the knife murder of her colonel husband. Brig. Gen. O. S. Rolfe, commanding general of headquarters and service command of the Far East command, put his stamp of approval on the court martial sentence. Mrs. Smith, daughter of retired Gen. Walter Krueger was confined at the Army Medical Corps Hospital at Fort Detrick, Md., where she is being held in solitary confinement.

Not Like The Old Days... Passing Out Political Plums Becomes Headache For GOP

WASHINGTON, Feb. 9—UP—Some Republican congressmen who waited more than 20 years for a chance to pick postmasters find they may have to let their patronage plums fall to Democrats. Democrats have been appointing postmasters for so long that Republicans in some districts just haven't bothered to apply and take examinations for the posts. A congressman, when his party is in power, makes the selection for a postmaster in his district from a list of three applicants who came out highest on examinations for the post. The congressman's recommendation is almost invariably followed by the President, who makes the actual appointments.

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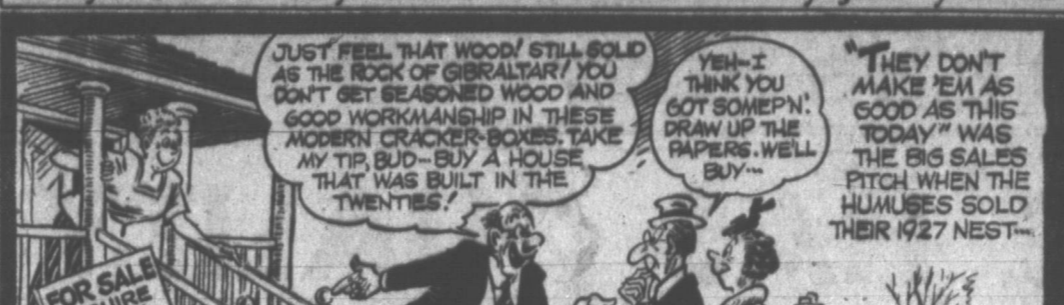

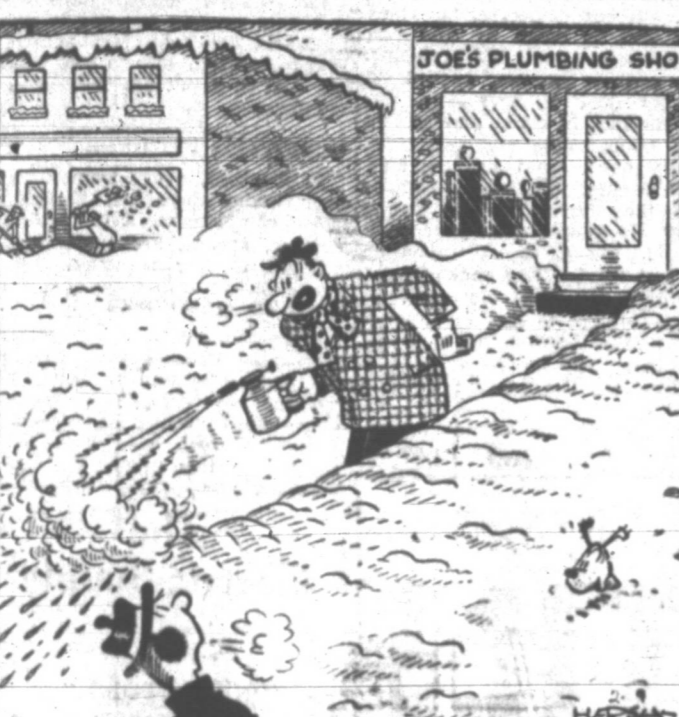

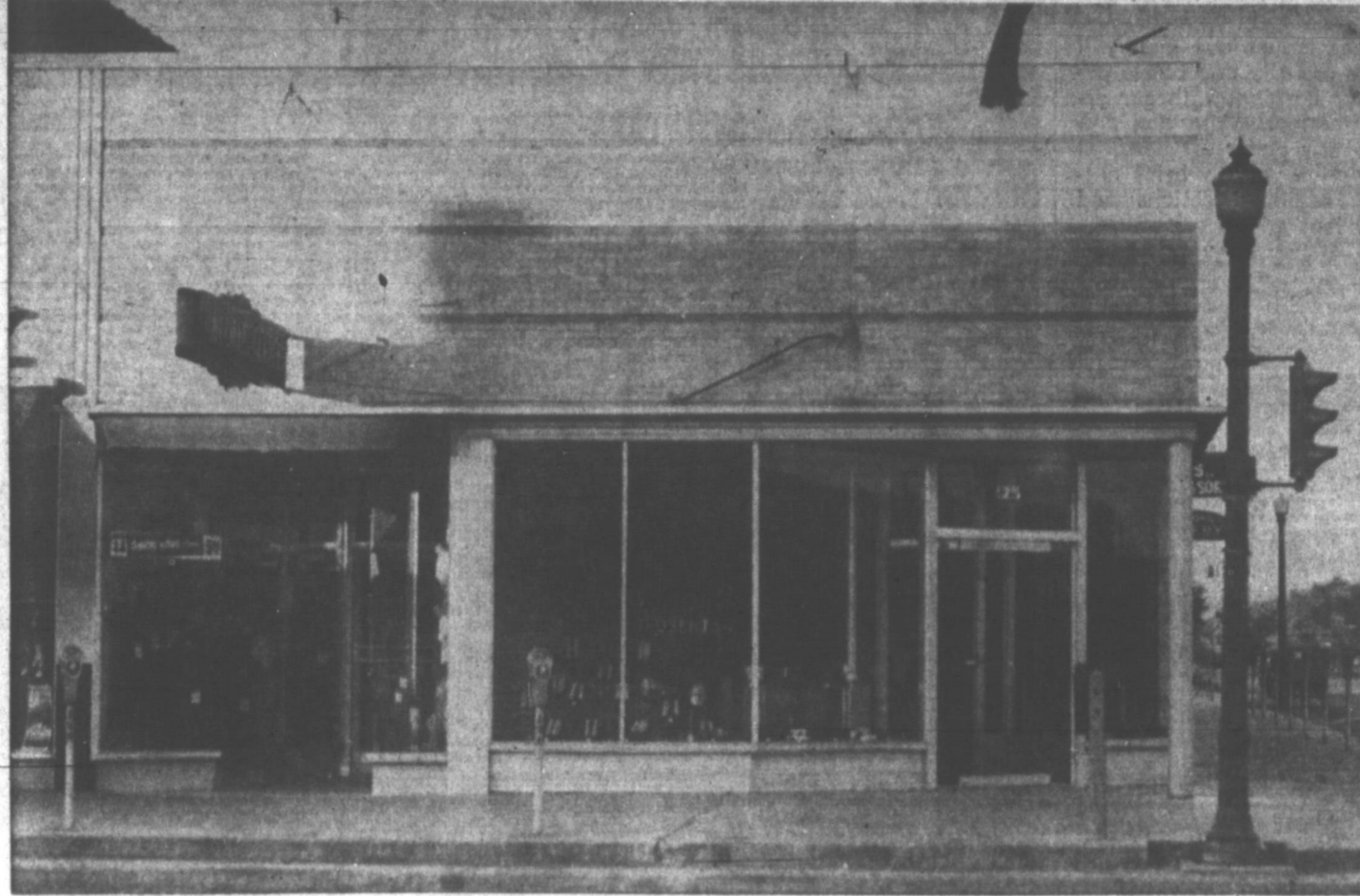
