In the Sep tember issue it had a sor under the general heading of "The Keystone of Liberty." It was written by Pier- re Lhoste-Lachaume. It is divided Ie tho LThe Liberal Era of the 19th into Century" "Fifty Years of Liberal Century," "Fitty Years o Retreating." and "The Time for Cholce." These sub-heads are again sub-divided. <br> The article points out that great progress was made in the 19 in Century in promoting liberty. During that century England and France adopted, to a large extent, France adopted, to a large extent, free trade. Of course, there was great progress made in the 18th Century also.
