LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (AP) - The bankruptcy of Little Rock-based Affliated Foods Southwest Inc. has wiped
out about $\$ 34$ million in investments held by more than 600 employees or members of the cooperative. The investors are from Arkansas, Alabama, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Mississippi,
Oklahoma, Tennessee and Texas.
The investments known as certificates of indebted ness are part of the unsecured debt held by Affiliated. Unsecured debts would be among the last paid as the
The amounts range from $\$ 8$ to more than $\$ 2.2$ million held by Shirley Davis - the widow of former Chief Executive Officer Jerry Davis who died in 2004. Filings in bankruptcy court show more than 60 investors lost at leas
Affiliated Foods was a wholesale cooperative owned by member grocery stores. It supplied hundreds of gro-
cery stores in Arkansas, Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi cery stores in Arkansas,
