Lawyer: Accused Fort Hood gunman may be paralyzed

FORT HOOD, Texas
(AP) - The Army psychi(AP) - The Army psychi-
atrist accused in the fatal
shootings at Fort Hood shootings at Fort Hood
may be paralyzed from the waist down after being
shot multiple times during shot multiple times during
the attack, his attorney told the attack, his attorney told
The Associated Press on Friday. Civilian attorney John Galligan said Maj. Nidal
Malik Hasan told him that he had no feeling in his legs and extreme pain in his hands. Hasan, who wa
shot four times by shot four times by civilian
police officers, said docpolice officers, said do
tors told him the condition may never improve. Galligan said he spoke
with Hasan for with Hasan for about an hour in the intensive
care unit at Brooke Army care unit at Brooke Army
Medical Center in San Antonio on Thursday, the same day Hasan was charged with 13 counts
premeditated murder. The attack at the spraw ing Texas post last week
injured 43 people injured 43 people, including 34 who suffered gun-
shot wounds. The military shot wounds. The military
initially said 29 people and Hasan had been wounded but some of the injuries came to the attention of
authorities days later they pieced together wha they peced together what
happened the day of the shooting.
Galligan said that his Galligan said that his
client's medical condition client's medical condition
remains "extremely serious" and that Hasan didn't flinch when Galligan
touched his leg touched his leg. One of

to see him Thursday for the first time since he was hospitalized.

| law violators in Texas could face additional consequences for their actions under an interstate agreesion of hunting, fishing and rapping licenses in other <br> The Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission approved a regulation for Texas to join 31 other states currently. participating in the Interstate Wildlife Violator Compact. <br> The Interstate Wildlife Violator Compact is an agreement that unresolved hunting and fishing vioations in one state can affect a person's hunting or fishing privileges in other participating states. Any person whose license privileges or rights are suspended in a member state could also be denied future purchase of a license in Texas until they have satsfied suspension in the other state. If a person's hunting, fishing, or trapping rights are suspended Texas, they may also suspended in member tates as well. <br> "This cooperative intertate effort will enhance Texas game wardens' abilty to protect and manage ur wildlife resources," said Maj. David Sinclair, |

plans to hunt, fish, or trap
in Texas and they have
a license suspension in
another state, this compact
allows us to deny them a

Violator Compact also
establishes a process
whereby wildlife law vio-
lations by a non-resident
from a member state are
handled as if the person
were a resident, meaning
they can be served a ticket
rather than being arrested,
booked, and bonded. This
process is a convenience
for hunters, fishermen, and
trappers of member states,
and increases efficiency of
game wardens by allowing
more time for enforcement
duties rather than violator
processing procedures.
