to code. Is it important to visit and
check on it often? What are some check on it often? What are some

Dear Jen: Having everything Dear Jen: Having everything
built to code is comforting, but it built to code is comforting, but it
really only ensures that the house will not collapse around you a year or two from now. The code require ments are the basic minimum for
sound construction, and you will sound construction, and you wil
most probably want to have some design upgrades from strictly code-built house.
The details in your building conract are probably your first stage of just insluding a phrase such as "acceptable material," your plans and contract should include as many specifics in areas that ar
most concern to you. If you can get out
almost every day, on a random schedule, this would be advisable.
The general contractor is The general contractor is supposed to keep an eye on his subcontrac-
tors, but he probably has sever al construction projects going on al construction projects going on
simultaneously in various stages of progress to monitor.
You cannot rely totally on the wuilding inspectors, either. The where flaws such as wiring, plumbing, roofing, etc., can result in cata strophic problems, but you cannot expect them to find all the minc material and workmanship flaws.
If you do make your inspection during working hours, be gentle with your questions and concern about the materials, and especially sional, the subcontractors will not like to be overly criticized. Keep in mind that most subcontractor are conscientious about doing a acceptable job
