New balanced budget for Pampa Independent School District

- PISD employees to get
2.5 percent pay raises

During its meeting at the Carver Administrative Center on Thursday night, the Pampa Independent School District Board of Trustees approved a new
balanced budget that included a pay raise for PISD employees.
Employees will now receive a 2.5 percent pay raise at the midpoint of their pay range, with each teacher expected to have a raise of $\$ 1,200$ during the next fiscal year.

The an employee's health insurance the district pays for $\$ 300$ annually, and employees that don't take PISD's insurance will receive a medical reimbursement card
"The board was very committed to supporting our employees, and you study where your compensatio employees, and you study where your compensation
plan is, versus the rest of the state, or versus your
neighbors," said Young. "We looked at information
for neighboring school districts about what kind of pay increase were they giving. Last year, the vast majority of school districts did not do any pay raise
at all" Young added that employee compensation is important in order to recruit and retain teachers and praised the PISD board on their dedication to the kids of the community.
"I continue to be impressed by the commitment of our board to the kids and the staff of this school district, said Young. Their attitude in deciding to totally focused on student success and the hard work our teachers do.
"I know all of the employees of the school district will join me in thanking them for their care and con-
cern for our employees and for our kids."

Today's Highlight in History
On July 1, 1862, President Abraham Lincoln signed the first Pacific Railroad Act "to aid in the construction of a

meat. Place in stock pot, and cover with water by several inches. Add enough chicken bouillon to make a flavorful broth. Add a few stalks sliced celery, and few carrots if desired. Bring to a boil and allow to simmer for 15 minutes. Using 10 flour tortillas, cut into two-inch pieces and put in the pot, stirring to
