Chautauqua 5K Run and 1K Fun Run results

This past Saturday 169 runners lined the downtown streets of Pampa to compete in the Chautauqua 5K run and the 1K fun run near Central Park.

The annual races were sponsored by Pampa Regional Medical Center, and runners from Texas, New Mexico, and Colorado lined up to compete for metals in 5 age categories.

There were a total of 71 runners competing in the 5K, and 98 in the 1K Fun Run with 9 different age categories.

The ages of the participants competing in the run spanned 75 years, with a young competitor of two years old competing in the 1K, and on the other end of the spectrum a gentleman aged 77. With all involved runners attacking the streets of Pampa.

The medals of gold, silver, and bronze were awarded in each division, and despite runners from other locations, each category were won by Pampa residents.

After the fun run participants and families alike gathered for the results at the pavilion in Central Park.

Texas A&M AgriLife Extension to host meeting and tour

An agronomist and an entomologist for the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will be on hand to make presentations.

Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in Carson and Gray counties will be hosting a Cotton Meeting and Tour on Tuesday, September 11th. The educational meeting will be sponsored by the Carson County Gin.

Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. at the Gin located three miles west of White Deer on Highway 60. The program will begin at 9:00 a.m. at the Dudley Pohnert Irrigated Cotton Variety Trial, located 2 1/2 miles south of White Deer on FM 294, then approxi-

mately half a mile west on CR 15, with the field being on the south side of the road.

Mark Kelley, agronomist for the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will be presenting information on cotton varieties and their characteristics, and Cotton Management and Development as well as area seed company representatives.

Following Kelley's presentation, Dr. Ed Bynum, Texas A&M AgriLife entomologist will discuss Cotton Insect Management. Nick Kenney will discuss on Cotton Irrigation Management and at the conclusion the tour will move to the Warminski Drip Irrigation Field where he will speak on Drip

Irrigation.

The tour will then head to the Chris Rapstine Dryland Variety Plot where Dryland Cotton Management will be discussed.

At approximately 12:15 p.m. we will move to the White Deer Community Center where a lunch will be provided for participants.

After lunch Dee Dee Jones of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension will speak on Cotton Market Outlook. Three CEUs will be offered. You must RSVP to Jody Bradford at the Carson County Extension Office at 537-3882 or to the Gray County Extension Office at 669-8033 by noon on September 10.
