



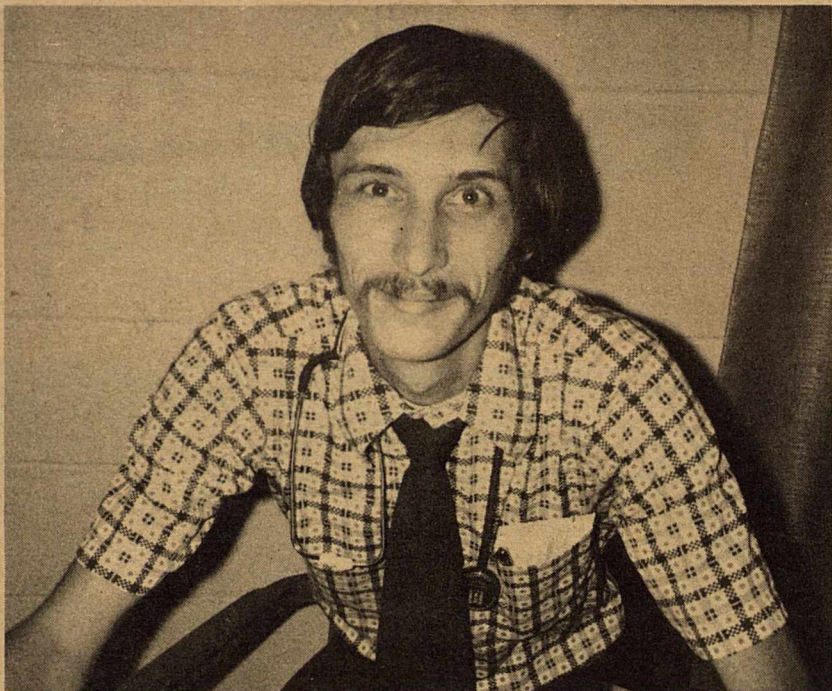

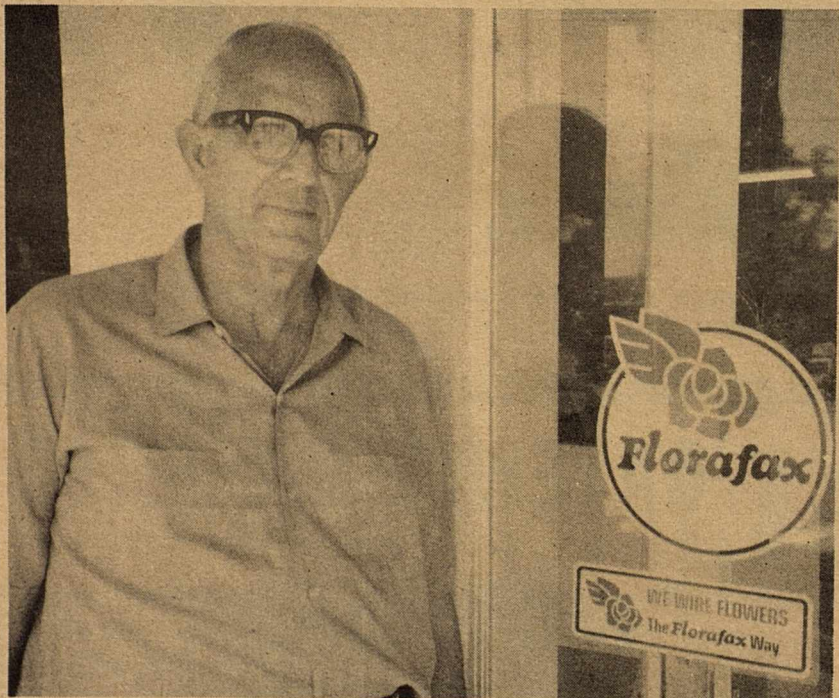
BRACKETT GROWS GROWS GROWS

Jason Warren is visiting his Grandmother, Mrs. Clara July. Jason is from Kerrville.

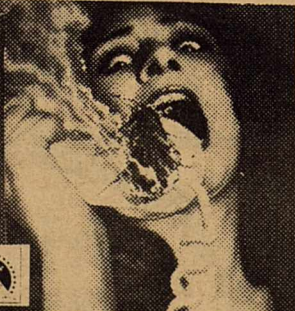
