GREEN THUMBS

by: JOE TOWNSEND

Now that the extreme heat has broken it is high time to begin to plant fall gardens. Fall tomato plants should be put in the ground as soon as possible.

Green beans should be planted immediately. Beets are a good bet for planting now. Swiss Chard and various greens, mustards, turnip, etc., can well be planted now. It is somewhat early to plant cabbage, cauliflower, brussel sprouts and head lettuce but ground should be prepared for the time to plant these will be very soon.

Prepare your ground as thoroughly as for spring planting. It is a common fault for people to assume the ground is already in good shape because they have been using it all summer.

Be sure the soil is well worked, fertilized ready for planting. Use the same care for fall planting as you did last spring. If we have a normal rainfall there is time for lots of good eating of fresh vegetables for the garden before frost.

The humming birds are still here. They had been gone more than two weeks by this time last year.

LETTERS to the editor

Dear Editor:

The organization I am writing about is the Trilateral Commission.

A question asked by the reader could be: "What is it and how does it concern me?" To answer the first part. It is an organization composed of the wealthiest, and most influential persons in the United States, Canada, Japan, and Werstern Europe. By influential, I mean persons who are Chairmen, Presidents, Vice-Presidents, and Directors of Large corporations and companies -- both domestic and international. The Carter administration is a Trilateral one, for the President, Vice-President and the overwhelming majority of his cabinet has been or are members.

To answer the second part of the question, this organization admits to being a policypriented organiation. The literature released or printed by the Commission states "The renovation (to make new) of the international system will be a very prolonged process. The system shaped after World War II was created through an act of will and human initiative in a relatively restricted period of time. One power had overwhelming might and nfluence and other were closely associated with it. In contrast, a renovated international system will now require a process of creation -- much longer and more complex -- in which prolonged negotiations will have to be initiated and developed. In nuturing (train, educate) habits and practices of working

together among the Trilateral regions, the Commission should help set the context (whole situation, background) for these mercenary efforts."

To the local independent businessmen, famers, and rancher the message should be clear. This organization is going to control the negotiations of trade between nations and domestic business. This control will be over all trade (industrial and agricultural).

I as an American was taught by my family, that if I worked hard, and had enough incentive, and got a lucky break, then I could progress upward economically. Under the Triliteralist it would be next to impossible, if not impossible, for a few would control all.



SHEEP & GOAT RAISERS NEWS

No one's going to claim that Texas. it always works this way, but it did at least this once. A resolution passed at the Texas Sheep and Goat Raiser's Association con- at the Del Rio Convention was a vention in Del Rio on a Friday bore ripe fruit by the following Wednesday. (in fact, it may have ripened even more quickly, but no one had had a chance to check on it any sooner.)

The resolution requested Texas Attorney General John Hil to appoint Austin lawyer Tom Buckle as special assistant Attorney General to represent the State of Texas in the Wyoming toxicant law-Friend. suit. In a Wednesday conversation with a TS&GRA director, Hill reportedly acknowledged that he did indeed make the appointment, subject to Buckle's acceptance.

Buckles has been associated with Hill's o, fice and has only recently opened a private practice. The lawsuit, scheduled to

go to court this fall, seeks to reinstate certain chemical toxicants for predator control use. It was initiated by the State of Wyoming and has since been joined by other states, including Buckle is firmly backgrounded in the case through his work with Hill's office.

Among other actions taken resoultion joining the National Cattleman's Association in their opposition to the threatened removal or further restriction on use of the herbicide 2,4,5T.

Other resoluations included an expression of appreciation to those who helped organize the convention and expressions of sympathy to the families of the late Ed V. Jarrett and the late W.E.

TS&GRA members elected Norman V. Rousselot, Sonora, to the association's presidency and picked Martin Wardlaw, Del Rio, as first Vice-President. The two has previously served as first and second vice-presidents respectively. San Angeloan Joe Mertz was elected to fill Wardlaw's position as second Vice-President.

Other elections included those of four new directors for life. They are Frank Fulk, Ft. Stockton; A.H. (fred) Walker, Comstock; John G. Dooley, Uvadle and Charles Darley, Brady. They join 37 other directors for life

In its general session, the association passed a By-laws change raising annual membership dues. Regual members will now pay \$1.50 per bag of wool and mohair, up from \$1. The minimum charge is now \$15 instead of \$10. Most assoiate memberships will cost \$15 per year, up from \$10 or \$12.50. Bank and loan company memberships remain the same at \$25 to \$50 and supporting memberships increased from \$5 to \$7.50.


Present Day Myths JOE TOWNSEND







SOUTHWEST TEXAS COUNTIES RANK HIGH IN VEGETABLES

(Among Top 10)

UVALDE--Four Southwest Texas counties claimed a good share of the \$283 million commercial vegetable crop produced in Texas in 1977.

According to figures released by the U.S.Department of Agriculture's Statistical Reporting Serive, FRIO, UVALDE, LA SALLE, AND ZAVALA counties all ranked in the top 10 vegetable producing counties in the state.

Frio County ranked third with 8,300 acres. Uvalde and Zavala ranked seventh and eighth with 5,650 and 5,550 acres respectively, and La Salle County ranked thenth with 3,700 acres. Statewide there were 212,610 acres harvested from 16 vege-atables produced in the State.



It is most difficult to measure the amount of time, effort and energy expended to carry out a program such as this.


When you consider that the work of planning and implementation was done on a volunteer basis the feat is even more amazing. There seemed to be not the least detail forgotten.





VEGETABLE Task Force

An old saying states: "Anything worth doing at all is worth doing root-prining feeding habits, are right." This is particularly applies to vegetable gardening.

Many novice gardeners can understand the importance of choosing a sunny location for a garden. Most realize existing grass and weeds should be removed before planting. All gardeners understand that soil must be loosened before the seeding and transplanting can be accomplished easily.

But few realize that adequate and proper soil preparation before garden establishment will greatly determine whether the garden is a success or a failure. ingredients mixed into the gar-THis is especially true in south central Texas where soils are alkaline rather than acid as they are in most other regions of the United States.

If a mistake was made by not properly preparing your garden soil last spring, now is the time to correct it. This should be done before establishing the fall garden, since soil problems encountered during the spring rowing season can be expected in the fall also.

Heavy clay soils, which are sticky when wet and as hard as a brick when dry, will be much ## easier to cultivate if a washed, coarse sand is added. Sand must be of a washed type to insure removal of a calcuim carbonate which makes garden soils even more alkaline. Add three inches of sand to the garden surface if the soil is to be tilled to a 10-inch depth.

Gypsum (calcium sulfate) also can be added to a "sticky" soil to make it more workable. Gypsum is a neutral product which does not increase or decrease the soil's alkalinity. Not only is it a good soil conditioner, but it also furnished certain amounts of available calcium which may aid in preventing such minor element disorders as blossoms end rot of tomatoes and cabbage leaf

If cavities have been noticed in the center of broccoli and cauliflower stems, add boron Holes in the center of the stems of these cole crops are caused by a boron deficiency. Since boron is a minor element, add only small amount to the garden area. one-half pound of a boron product such as Twenty Mule Team Borax per 1,000 square feet of gardening area will supply the needed amount. Boron toxicity can occur if too much is added, so use only what is required for your gardening area.

Fertilizer also must be added for the fall crop since spring fertilization has been washed out of the soil and used for plant growth. Use a balanced fertilizer such as 10-10-5, or 10-10-10, or 10-20-5 at the rate of 15 pounds per 1,000 square feet or 2 pouns per 100 square feet. If manures are used, 200 or 500 pounds per 1,000 square feet or 20 to 50 pounds per square 100 feet should be adequate. Incorporate fresh manure into the soil several weeks before planting.

If heavy infestations of wireworms, which produce holey potatoes, or grubworms, which cause stunted plants because of present, a soil insecticide such as diazionon should be added.

If a new garden area which was previously lawn has been chosen for fall, grubworm infestations proably will occur and should be treated before crop establishment. Soil insecticide treatments will control only soil insects and will not be effective against insect problems on the top portion of the plant. These insecticides are not taken into the plants by the Foot system.

Soils should be well pulverized at least 10 inches deep, den area, a nematicide added, if necessary. Make rows 36 inches apart, but in small gardens these can be spaced closer.

After rows have been "piled" or built, pack firmly with a hoe or shovel so that water will pentrate well. I recommend furrow (ditches between the rows) watering in the fall to prevent water scalding by droplets on leaves disease proliferation, and soil crusting. A properly prepared soil insures a successful fall arden rather than a disappointing




