The hostage crisis in Lebanon ended safely on Sunday, June 30 th and all the 39 hostages should be back with their families by the 4 th of July. And I am sure that the upper level politicians of our country will growl and grumble and rattle the sabers as to what we are going to do if this happens again. But this brings to mind the question, "What are we going to do about it?"
Any hostage situation is a touchy, delicate situation that must be handled in ways that are distasteful to those who have to negotiate with the criminals responsible. The primary goal of course is to obtain the safe release of the hostage or hostages involved with the least possible concessions to the demands of the criminals holding them. This is true on whatever scale the crisis is on, be it a drunken, distraught husband in a small town holding his wife and children or fanatic terrorists in the Middle East such as Iran or Lebanon. The difference is that in most case the criminal or criminals face punishment for their crimes and that punishment is at least a possible deterrent to future crimes of violence. International terrorist in most cases face no such punishment and somewhere, somehow this has got tol change.

The recent hostage situation in the Middle East has angered the citizens of the United States and other free countries throughout the world. We hear many suggestions and cries for reprisal and I certainly agree that some type of action must be taken to put the thugs, hijackers, and terrorists of the world on notice that the United States will no longer stand by quietly and allow it's citizens to be kidnapped, beaten, assassinated and terrorized.
During the early 1950 's a country in Africa, Kenya, by name, was under the control of Britain and some factions of terrorists in that country began raiding the farms and small settlements using machetes to hack off arms, heads, and generally terrorize the native population as well as the white landowners. So called "Leopard Men" used dried feet of dead leopards with the claws extended to maim and disfigure native workers on the farms to encourage them to join the terrorists and rise up against their white employers. Groups of white hunters and landowners decided to use the terrorists own methods against them with a siight little twist. They built cages and trapped live leopards and put them in the cages. They then raided terrorist camps and took live captives, leaving one captive out to witness this unique form of frontier justice. After the leopards had done their work the

captive would be released to carry the news back to his terrorist friends of the fate that awaited them. In no time at all the attacks of the "Leopard Men" ceased and the uprising was put down in a very short time. Terrorists only understand terror. Meeting their demands and scolding them and rattling sabers has no effect on the mind of a terrorist. I know it is hard for a nation of people who have lived the soft life for too long such as we have here in the United States to understand this fact and it is hard to condone cruel, terroristic methods of reprisal, but these acts will continue until the criminals responsible receive as good as they give.
Let us not forget that a U.S. Navy man was brutally mistreated, beaten, and finally murdered just because he was a U.S. military man in the service of his country. We also have seven other U.S. citizens still captive or dead that were kidnapped in Lebanon by radical terrorists.
What is the answer and what type of action should be taken? I don't have the answer and smarter men that $I$ who have access to much more information that any of us do not seem to have the answer either. We must realize that many countries and the people of those countries do not have the same moral point of view and/or belief of right and wrong that we do here in the U.S. Taking a human life or giving their own for their cause is not only acceptable but is encouraged by their fellow terrorists and leaders. The sucide bombers being used to blow up our embassies is a prime example.
At the moment about all we can do is to remember the lives lost to terroristic actions and not forget that there are still other Americans being held illegally by terrorists in the Middle East. In my opinion all the joyful celebrations for the returned hostages are hollow and false as long as there is even one American being held by terrorists in any country and as long as the lives taken by terrorists remain unavenged. Maybe we should think more about the method used against the "Leopard Men" of Kenya!!
