— 27. April. Castro bat das Pferd des Major Howard, welches er bei seiner Flucht mitnahm, in das Fort Inge am Howard's Bruder abgeben lassen, während er selbst im Lager der Sipans sich aufhielt. Der im Fort Inge kommandirende Offizier schickte darauf 25 Mann nach dem Lager der Sipans um Castro festzunehmen und in das Fort zu bringen. Als die Soldaten an das Lager der Indianer kamen, floh Castro mit seinen Leuten. Der alte Castro und einige Indianer und Indianerinnen kamen zum Fort Inge, wo sie von Major Howard zurückgelassen und der Wache übergeben wurden.

Alle Vermuthungen laufen da hinaus, daß die letzten Raubereien und Mordthaten durch die Sipans von jenseits des Rio Grande in Verbindung mit den Sipans dieses Theils des Rio Grande und Seminolen verübt worden seien. (S. A. 3.)

**Santa Fe.** 28. März. Wir erhielten die Nachricht, daß die Sipans in diesem Gebiete wieder neue Raubereien verübt hätten. Am 26. v. M. kamen sie nach Santa Fe und raubten ungefähr 30 Pferde. Gelegentlich wurde ein Pferd, das im Lager bei Burgwin kommandirt, Nachricht von dem Verlust gefordert. Am Morgen des 28. wurde eine Compagnie Tragoner zur Verfolgung dieser Indianer aus, begleitet von dem Indianeragenten Kit Carson und ungefähr 20 freiwilligen Bürgern.

Ein Brief datirt vom 9. April von Herrn James Taylor von hier, der sich jetzt in El Paso, auf dem Wege nach California befindet, meldet, daß durch die Santa Fe Post, die letzten angekommen sei, ein neuer seltener Kampf bei Taos in Neu-Mexico zwischen 2 Compagnien S. T. Tragoner und ungefähr 300 Utao und Apache Indianer stattgefunden haben. Die U. T. sind zwar von mehreren 40 Mann einhellig zweier Offiziere. 10 Mann wurden verwundet und 8 entamen.

Durch einen anderen Brief erfahren wir, daß 300 Utao und Apache Indianer in der Nähe von Navajo's Meertöten vertrieben. Ein allgemeiner Indianerkrieg steht im Anzuge. (Santa Fe Gazette.)
