This new line will be about 300 miles long and will afford a new and di-

The cunstruction of the railroad which Talmage of Chicago and associates are to build from a point on the Pecos Valley line near Canyon City, in the Pan handle, to San Antonio will soon e commenoed, according to advices received here. The survey for more than 150 miles of its pro pored road south from its cen nection with the Pecos Valley has been fivished and the North ern Texas Construction company is ready to push the conetruction work with vigor. Mr. Talmadge and associates $a^{\prime}$ so propose to build a branch line from a point on the main line near Canyon Ui y to El Paso. The main line will be about 450 miles long and the branch line atout $\mathbf{3} 25$ miles Mr. Talmadge is one of the most prominent railroad colonizers in the west.
